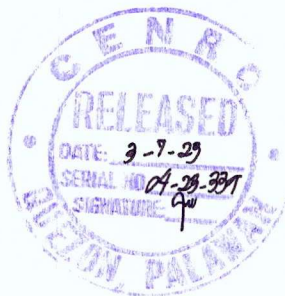

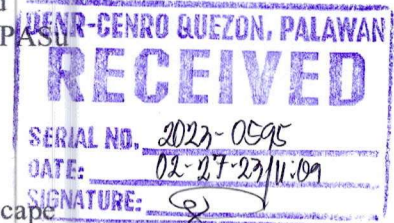

SUBJECT : **PROGRESS REPORT ON THE CREATION OF COMMUNICATION PLAN FOR MT. MANTALINGAHAN PROTECTED LANDSCAPE UNDER DENR WFP CY 2023**



This is to inform that the undersigned staff of Mount Mantalingahan Protected Landscape (MMPL) have conducted a two (2) days meeting with NGO partners particularly the USAID SIBOL and Conservation International (CI) last February 16-17, 2023 at Training Hall, DENR-PENRO, Sta. Monica, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan to improve the draft five (5) years communication plan for MMPL.

The meeting to create the MMPL five (5) years communication plan was set in two phases via semi-virtual manner. The first phase was the presentation of previous communication plans and programs of the participants including the PAMO, success stories and difficulties encountered which hindered the full accomplishment of their objectives. The second phase was the actual planning which will include identifying activities, setting timeframe, setting roles and identifying resources.

During the first day, MMPL PAMO presented the institutional AVP of MMPL, discussed its brief history and management programs to enlighten the participants and have ideas on what communication interventions will fit in MMPL. It was followed by the presentation of communication strategies, program difficulties and solutions created by SIBOL and CI. Via online, Mr. Jess Pagliawan the communication officer of CI informed that they have been focusing on tenured areas and building strong connection with IP communities thru regular visitation as their foremost strategy. They also regularly assist the PAMO in conducting activities for MMPL day celebration such as the recently conducted Dalaw Turo at Iraan, Rizal and Saraza, Brooke's Point. Also via online, Mr. Jovan Cerda communication specialist of USAID SIBOL shared that one of their strategy is the use of social media platforms like Facebook and YouTube as channels for information dissemination.

In the afternoon of phase one (1), the participants were able to identify additional programs and activities for the communication plan. Highlighted programs are annual celebration of MMPL day, Joining Municipal Festivals and Integration of MMPL and Environmental knowledges and activities to the curriculum and activities of schools serving communities within and around MMPL.

The second day/phase 2 started with recapitulation by the PAMO followed by cleaning inputs from phase 1 of the meeting of participants. Mr. Cyril Ramil Dacillo of USAID SIBOL suggested to show the direct connection of created programs and activities to the targets/goals of MMPL that are stated in the MMPL PAMP 2021-2030. While Mr. Jess Pagliawan suggested to include the Integration of MMPL and Environmental knowledges and activities to the curriculum and activities of schools serving communities within and around MMPL as a 5 year working program considering that such project would involve high level decision making while doing properly documented educational activities to justify the need to establish the targeted long term program. Both SIBOL and CI commits their support in the finalization and implementation of the five (5) year communication plan.

Further, this is only the first step towards the creation of the 5-year communication plan for MMPL. The latter will be presented to MMPL TWG for evaluation and improvement and then in the PAMB en banc for further comment and approval.

Moreover, this activity was involved by three female MMPL PAMO personnel who showcased excellent performance as secretariat during meeting.

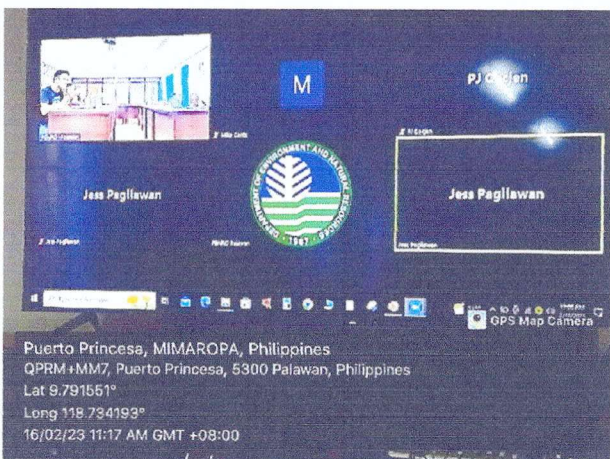
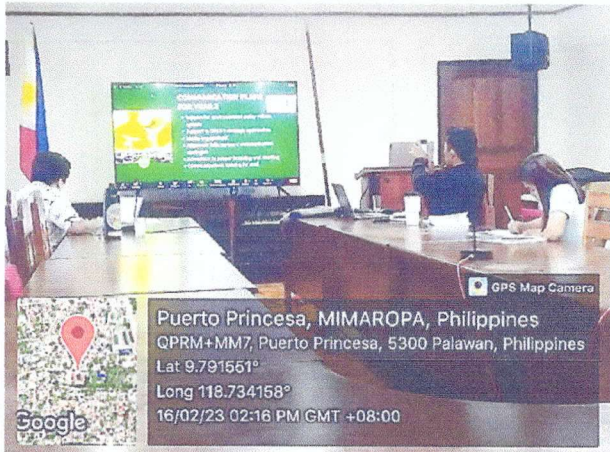

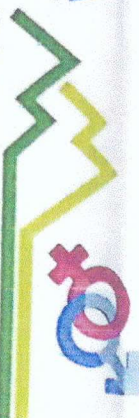
