Please be informed that on February 9, 2023 and February 15-16, 2023, the undersigned together with Park Rangers of the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) conducted habitat surveillance of threats and damages within the mangrove area of Abolan River, Bgy. Alacalian, Taytay, and coral areas of Bgys. Tumbod and Liminangcong, Taytay, Palawan. A total of three (3) sites were monitored and observed burnt trunks of mangroves used for charcoal making. Likewise, no damage/threats were observed in the coral area.


