Greetings!

This pertains to the site investigation conducted by CENRO-Coron personnel, last 15 February 2023, regarding the river quarrying operations in Taberna Steel Bridge along Busuanga River.

During the investigation, the following information were gathered:

Three (3) individuals were seen assembling a raft or balsa at the subject area. Mr. Ivan Pastor
was interviewed regarding the transaction on the buying and selling of the river aggregates.
He mentioned that interested residents contact them to buy a certain amount of aggregates
sold for PhP 1,500 per cubic meter. Before quarrying, they go to the
Provincial Mining
Regulatory Board (PMRB) to request to conduct river quarrying through an "Order of
Payment (OP)" which amounts to PhP 250.00 per cubic meter.

The CENRO-Coron personnel requested a copy of the OP, but Mr. Pastor mentioned that they don't get any receipts upon payment. He also stated that the OP is paid as a violation or

penalty because they conduct river quarrying without a permit.

Mr. Pastor disclosed that the collected aggregates are only for household use, wherein an
average of 5 to 10 cu. m. is utilized per household. He emphasized that they do not provide

any aggregates to big construction projects.

4. An earlier apprehension was also reported last 29 January 2023 involving Mr. Arik Simproso where a barangay hearing was held for further investigation. Based on the Minutes of the Meeting, the PMRB, represented by Kap. Tess, will no longer allow river quarrying activities in Taberna Steel Bridge. However, PMRB will allow such activities in applied areas of Catiil and Sariego.

5. During the said meeting, Kap. Tess also explained how the approval process of individuals that will conduct river quarrying. Before extracting, applicants must send a request to PMRB, secure a Barangay clearance, pay the corresponding amount based on the volume of aggregates to be extracted, and must be inspected first by PMRB officials.

In view thereof, we are respectfully requesting information regarding such transaction processes, legal bases, or written resolutions allowing individuals to conduct river quarrying for household use or "humanitarian consideration".

Your utmost cooperation will be highly appreciated.

 Pastor was interviewed regarding the transaction on the buying and selling of the river
 aggregates. He mentioned that interested residents contact them to buy a certain amount
 of aggregates sold for PhP 1,500 per cubic meter. Before quarrying, they go to the
 Provincial Mining Regulatory Board (PMRB) to request to conduct river quarrying
 through an "Order of Payment (OP)," which amounts to PhP 250.00 per cubic meter.
- 2. The CENRO-Coron personnel requested a copy of the OP, but Mr. Pastor mentioned that they don't get any receipts upon payment. He also stated that the OP is paid as a violation or penalty because they conduct river quarrying without a permit.
- Mr. Pastor disclosed that the collected aggregates are only for household use, wherein
 an average of 5 to 10 cu. m. is utilized per household. He emphasized that they do not
 provide any aggregates to big construction projects.
- 4. An earlier apprehension was also reported last 29 January 2023 involving Mr. Arik Simproso. Based on the Minutes of the Meeting provided by your office, during a meeting with Mr. Simproso and PMRB, it was agreed that any river quarrying activities will no longer be allowed in Taberna Steel Bridge. However, PMRB will allow such activities in applied areas of Catiil and Sariego.

Pursuant to DENR Administrative Order (DAO) No. 2010-21, otherwise known as the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act (RA) No. 792, otherwise known as the Philippine Mining Act of 1995, the extracted materials within the subject area are considered illegally-sourced mineral/mineral products which violate Section 116 Chapter XII of the above-mentioned administrative order, stating:

Section 116. Illegally-sourced minerals/mineral products are those which are mined, extracted, removed and/or disposed of without authority or permit under existing mining laws, rules, and regulations.

Hence, all river quarrying activities in Barangay Salvacion are hereby ordered to immediately CEASE AND DESIST until the required permit/s are secured from the proper authority. Any violations of the preceding actions will warrant the following penalties and liabilities under Section 103 of the same administrative order:

Section 103. Theft of Minerals. - Any person extracting minerals and disposing the same without a mining agreement, lease, permit, license, or steals minerals or ores or the products thereof from mines or mills or processing plants shall, upon conviction, be imprisoned from six (6) months to six (6) years or pay a fine from Ten thousand pesos (P10,000.00) to Twenty thousand pesos (P20,000.00), or both, at the discretion of the appropriate court. In addition, he shall be liable to pay damages and compensation for the minerals removed, extracted, and disposed of.

In view of the preceding, the Barangay is advised to strictly monitor sand and gravel activities in accordance with the powers, duties, and function of the Barangay Chief Executive as stipulated in Section 389 (b), Item. No. 9 of the RA No. 7160, or the Local Government Code of 1991:

(9) Enforce laws and regulations relating to pollution control and protection of the environment.

Please be guided accordingly.




Figure 1. Location map of the investigated river quarrying along Busuanga River, So. Lod, Brgy. Salvacion, Busuanga, Palawan.

- At the subject area, three (3) individuals were seen assembling a raft or balsa. The raft is approximately 5 meters by 3 meters (Photo 1). The raft can hold 50 sacks of 10 cu. m. river aggregates.
- 3. The undersigned interviewed Mr. Ivan Pastor regarding the transaction regarding the buying and selling of the river aggregates. He mentioned that interested residents contact them to buy a certain amount of aggregates sold for PhP 1,500 per cubic meter. Before quarrying, they go to the Provincial Mining Regulatory Board (PMRB) to request to conduct river quarrying through an "Order of Payment (OP)" which amounts to PhP 250.00 per cubic meter.
- 4. The undersigned requested a copy of the OP, but Mr. Pastor mentioned that they don't get any receipts upon payment. He also stated that the OP is paid as a violation or penalty because they conduct river quarrying without a permit.
- 5. Mr. Pastor disclosed that the collected aggregates are only for household use, wherein an average of 5 to 10 cu. m. is utilized per household. He emphasized that they do not provide any aggregates to big construction projects.
- 6. The undersigned proceeded to the Barangay Hall of Brgy. Salvacion and met with Hon. Henry G. Yala (Photo 2). According to Hon. Yala, a barangay hearing was held among the barangay officials, apprehended individuals, Mr. Arik Simproso, and the PMRB for further investigation and resolution.
- The undersigned requested a copy of the Minutes of the Meeting through a letter dated 20 February 2023, to gather more information on the matter.
- 8. The undersigned secured a copy of the apprehension report (Annex 1) and the minutes of the meeting last 06 March 2023 (Annex 2).

Here are some points for the minutes of the meeting:

23 individuals were caught extracting aggregates from the river;

8 rafts were seen in the subject area;

The aggregates will be used for the construction of the seawall;

No items were seized by the barangay;

 According to Kap Tess of PMRB, they will no longer allow the extraction of aggregates in Taberna Steel Bridge. However, PMRB will allow such activities in applied areas of Catiil and Sariego; and

 Before extracting, applicants must send a request to PMRB, secure a Barangay clearance, pay the corresponding amount based on the volume of aggregates to

be extracted, and must be inspected first by PMRB officials.

- 9. Hon. Yala's concerns were that the PhP 250.00 should be paid to them instead of PMRB or at least receive their share from utilizing mineral resources for the development of their community.
- 10. Hon. Yala also wanted the subject area to be exclusive to Barangay Salvacion residents only and should not be quarried by neighboring barangays.
- 11. The undersigned advised Hon. Yala to prohibit river quarrying in Busuanga River as well as other water bodies under his jurisdiction since the extraction of earth materials without a permit is illegal. He was reminded to inform the individuals conducting such activities to secure a permit first with the appropriate offices.

Comments and Recommendations

1. The exact location where they extract aggregates and river depth were not determined by the undersigned. However, it is reiterated that the recommended guidelines for River Quarrying are the following:

Maintain a 10-meter buffer zone from the banks;

Avoid extraction below the water table (depth of extraction = 1 meter); and

- Quarrying must not be carried out within 1 kilometer of any crucial hydraulic structure such as pumping stations, water intake, bridges, buildings, and such structures (unless a written consent from the concerned agency was secured).
- 2. As to the conduct of river quarrying without a permit, this violates Section 103 of the Republic Act 7942, otherwise known as the Philippine Mining Act of 1995.

Theft of Minerals. - Any person extracting minerals and disposing the same without a mining agreement, lease, permit, license, or steals minerals or ores or the products thereof from mines or mills or processing plants shall, upon conviction, be imprisoned from six (6) months to six (6) years or pay a fine from Ten thousand pesos (P10,000.00) to Twenty thousand pesos (P20,000.00), or both, at the discretion of the appropriate court. In addition, he shall be liable to pay damages and compensation for the minerals removed, extracted, and disposed of.

Upon questioning, they claim that a certain Hilario Simproso, a barangay kagawad of Barangay San Isidro had contracted them quarry and haul gravel and sand at the said location.

Section 116. Illegally-sourced minerals/mineral products are those which are mined, extracted, removed and/or disposed of without authority or permit under existing mining laws, rules, and regulations.

Hence, all river quarrying activities in Barangay Salvacion are hereby ordered to immediately CEASE AND DESIST until the required permit/s are secured from the proper authority. Any violations of the preceding actions will warrant the following penalties and liabilities under Section 103 of the same administrative order:

Section 103. Theft of Minerals. - Any person extracting minerals and disposing the same without a mining agreement, lease, permit, license, or steals minerals or ores or the products thereof from mines or mills or processing plants shall, upon conviction. be imprisoned from six (6) months to six (6) years or pay a fine from Ten thousand pesos (P10,000.00) to Twenty thousand pesos (P20,000.00), or both, at the discretion of the appropriate court. In addition, he shall be liable to pay damages and compensation for the minerals removed, extracted, and disposed of.

In view of the preceding, the Barangay is advised to strictly monitor sand and gravel activities in accordance with the powers, duties, and function of the Barangay Chief Executive as stipulated in Section 389 (b), Item. No. 9 of the RA No. 7160, or the Local Government Code of 1991:

(9) Enforce laws and regulations relating to pollution control and protection of the environment.

QUARRYING OPERATIONS ALONG BUSUANGA RIVER, SO.

LOD, BARANGAY SALVACION, BUSUANGA, PALAWAN

Under Travel Order No. 2023-002, the undersigned conducted a site investigation last 15 February 2023 in So. Lod, Brgy. Salvacion, Busuanga, Palawan. This is in response to the incident report regarding illegal quarrying in Busuanga River, dated 30 January 2023, from Patrick Israel T. Panlilio, Forest Technician I, of CENRO-Coron.

Background Information

Based on the report, 22 individuals were caught quarrying and hauling sand and gravel without a permit in Busuanga River last 29 January 2023. The report also included the names of the apprehended individuals. The individuals claimed that a certain "Hilario Simproso", a barangay kagawad of Brgy. San Isidro has ordered them to quarry in the said location.

Purpose and Scope

The undersigned conducted the fieldwork to investigate the river quarrying operations further. The investigation includes an ocular inspection of the site, photo documentation, a verbal interview with the said individuals, and apprehension, if necessary.

Findings and Observations




Figure 1. Location map of the investigated river quarrying along Busuanga River, So. Lod, Brgy. Salvacion, Busuanga, Palawan.

1. The subject area is along Busuanga River, So. Lod, Brgy. Salvacion, Busuanga. It is geographically situated at 12°9′10"N, 119°56′9"E. It is approximately 55.3 kilometers from CENRO, which is reachable by an hour of motorcycle ride (Figure 1).

- 2. At the subject area, three (3) individuals were seen assembling a raft or balsa. The raft is approximately 5 meters by 3 meters (Photo 1). The raft can hold 50 sacks of 10 cu. m. river aggregates.
- 3. The undersigned interviewed Mr. Ivan Pastor regarding the transaction regarding the buying and selling of the river aggregates. He mentioned that interested residents contact them to buy a certain amount of aggregates sold for PhP 1,500 per cubic meter. Before quarrying, they go to the Provincial Mining Regulatory Board (PMRB) to request to conduct river quarrying through an "Order of Payment (OP)" which amounts to PhP 250.00 per cubic meter.
- 4. The undersigned requested a copy of the OP, but Mr. Pastor mentioned that they don't get any receipts upon payment. He also stated that the OP is paid as a violation or penalty because they conduct river quarrying without a permit.
- 5. Mr. Pastor disclosed that the collected aggregates are only for household use, wherein an average of 5 to 10 cu. m. is utilized per household. He emphasized that they do not provide any aggregates to big construction projects.
- 6. The undersigned proceeded to the Barangay Hall of Brgy. Salvacion and met with Hon. Henry G. Yala (Photo 2). According to Hon. Yala, a barangay hearing was held among the barangay officials, apprehended individuals, Mr. Arik Simproso, and the PMRB for further investigation and resolution.
- 7. The undersigned requested a copy of the Minutes of the Meeting through a letter dated 20 February 2023, to gather more information on the matter.
- 8. The undersigned secured a copy of the apprehension report (Annex 1) and the minutes of the meeting last 06 March 2023 (Annex 2).

Here are some points for the minutes of the meeting:

- 23 individuals were caught extracting aggregates from the river;
- 8 rafts were seen in the subject area;
- The aggregates will be used for the construction of the seawall;
- No items were seized by the barangay;
- According to Kap Tess of PMRB, they will no longer allow the extraction of aggregates in Taberna Steel Bridge. However, PMRB will allow such activities in applied areas of Catill and Sariego; and
- Before extracting, applicants must send a request to PMRB, secure a Barangay clearance, pay the corresponding amount based on the volume of aggregates to be extracted, and must be inspected first by PMRB officials.
- Hon. Yala's concerns were that the PhP 250.00 should be paid to them instead of PMRB or at least receive their share from utilizing mineral resources for the development of their community.
- 10. Hon. Yala also wanted the subject area to be exclusive to Barangay Salvacion residents only and should not be quarried by neighboring barangays.
- 11. The undersigned advised Hon. Yala to prohibit river quarrying in Busuanga River as well as other water bodies under his jurisdiction since the extraction of earth materials without a permit is illegal. He was reminded to inform the individuals conducting such activities to secure a permit first with the appropriate offices.

Comments and Recommendations

- 1. The exact location where they extract aggregates and river depth were not determined by the undersigned. However, it is reiterated that the recommended guidelines for River Quarrying are the following:
 - Maintain a 10-meter buffer zone from the banks;
 - Avoid extraction below the water table (depth of extraction = 1 meter); and
 - Quarrying must not be carried out within 1 kilometer of any crucial hydraulic structure such as pumping stations, water intake, bridges, buildings, and such structures (unless a written consent from the concerned agency was secured).
- 2. As to the conduct of river quarrying without a permit, this violates Section 103 of the Republic Act 7942, otherwise known as the Philippine Mining Act of 1995.

Theft of Minerals. - Any person extracting minerals and disposing the same without a mining agreement, lease, permit, license, or steals minerals or ores or the products thereof from mines or mills or processing plants shall, upon conviction, be imprisoned from six (6) months to six (6) years or pay a fine from Ten thousand pesos (P10,000.00) to Twenty thousand pesos (P20,000.00), or both, at the discretion of the appropriate court. In addition, he shall be liable to pay damages and compensation for the minerals removed, extracted, and disposed of.

Furthermore, the extracted materials are considered illegally sourced mineral/mineral products. Based on Section 116 Chapter XII of DAO 2010-21,

Illegally-sourced minerals/mineral products are those which are mined, extracted, removed and/or disposed of without authority or permit under existing mining laws, rules and regulations.

- 3. To request PMRB to explain their transaction processes, "Order of Payment" for applicants, and how they approve the "humanitarian consideration" for individuals.
- 4. To issue a Cease-and-Desist Order for all river quarrying activities in Brgy. Salvacion until PMRB releases a formal resolution enumerating and adopting the existing transaction they have regarding river quarrying activities.
- 5. To conduct regular monitoring of Taberna Steel Bridge along Busuanga River by MGB and MES.



This pertains to the site investigation conducted by Ms. Alessa Anne S. Estorninos, Deputy Environment and Natural Resources Officer of the Mines and Geosciences Bureau, last 15 February 2023, regarding the seabed quarrying in Busuanga River.

Pursuant to Section 8 of DAO 2010-21 or the "Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. 7942, otherwise known as the Philippine Mining Act of 1995" the Local Government Units (LGUs) have a role to coordinate with the Department and Bureau in the implementation of the Act and these implementing rules and regulations in their respective jurisdictions.
