Background Information

Last 06 March 2023, the undersigned accompanied MGB-MIMAROPA personnel in conducting inventory and monitoring of the Cease-and-Desist Orders issued in Coron, Palawan.

During the monitoring in Brgy. San Nicolas, the undersigned passed by two (2) private properties alongside each other who have been extracting aggregates in their private property. The undersigned was assisted by Tanod Rudy Ampoan of Brgy. San Nicolas.

Findings and Observations

The subject areas are in Brgy. San Nicolas, Coron, Palawan with the following coordinates:

Mountain Staircase	12° 6'5.71"N, 120°10'7.00"E	
Mountain Quarry	12° 6'4.55"N, 120°10'7.14"E	

They are located along the San Nicolas-King Ranch road and are approximately 16 kilometers away from CENRO, which is reachable by a 30-minute car ride. Both are also located within the Busuang Pasture Reserve (BPR) (Figure 1).

A. Mountain Staircase

- The undersigned interviewed, Mrs. Emmalyn Delos Reyes, the caretaker of the subject area (Photo 1). According to her, they started developing the mountain staircase last January 2023. The purpose of this is to have a resthouse for the owner, Mr. Dave Manaeg (Photo 2).
- Mrs. Delos Reyes also disclosed that Mr. Manaeg is a current foreman of BCT Trading and Construction Inc. She also mentioned that the area is a titled property. However, no documents were presented to the undersigned.

B. Mountain Quarry

- According to Brgy. Tanod Ampon, no extraction of aggregates occurred in the subject area. Only flattening and clearing were conducted. No further information was gathered regarding the owner of the subject area.
- The subject area has been abandoned and no sign of recent extraction has been observed (Photo 3).

Comments and Recommendations

 To request Mr. Dave Manaeg to report to CENRO-Coron to clarify and provide more information regarding the ongoing developments in his private property and present pertinent documents to CENRO-Coron.




Photo 1. Interview with Mrs. Emmalyn Delos Reyes, the caretaker of the subject area.




Photo 3. Abandoned quarried mountain.
