History of Claim of Ownership

The subject of claim of ownership of the Municipal Government of Boac is the parcel of land that was formerly a portion of dried Boac Riverbed and located in Brgy. Murallon – Brgy. San Miguel, Poblacion, Boac, Marinduque.

On October 10, 1984, in accordance with the survey order of the Regional Land Director in compliance with the directive of Assistant Director Narciso V. Villapando as contained in a letter indorsement dated January 16, 1984 (as annotated in the approved survey plan – Mr. – 04-000001) Geodetic Engineer Teodoro Marquez had conducted land survey over the subject parcel of land having an area of 43, 144 square meters. On May 14, 1985, Regional Director Rodolfo A. Paelmo of the Bureau of Lands-Ministry of Natural Resources approved its survey plan, wherein it is stated therein that it is surveyed in favor of the Municipality of Boac as Municipal Renovation.

It is also stated therein that the subject parcel of land is identified as Lot 22172 and an additional lot of CADASTRAL 544-D, Boac Cadastre and inside alienable and disposable area as per property no. 1 Blk. 1, map No. 789 certified on November 28, 1928.

The history of claim of the Municipal Government of Boac over the subject parcel of land dates back as early as 1983, through Kapasiyahan blg. 22-83 and 19-84 (see attached copy) issued by the Sangguniang Bayan of Boac which might be the rationale for the issuanced of survey authority by the Regional Land Director and for the approval of the survey plan as Municipal Reservation for the Municipality of Boac on May 14, 1985.

On March 11, 1996, the Sangguniang Bayan of Boac approved Municipal Ordinance No. 95-037 An ordinance designating the eastern portion of the Boac River Bed (right side of the New Riverside Bridge) as part of Central Parking areas for public utility vehicles.

Through A Memorandum of Agreement dated October 24, 2013 the Municipality of Boac as first party has allowed on the subject land the second party to used and utilized an area specifically located on the western portion of the road leading to Barangay Tabi situated at Brgy. Murallon, Boac, Marinduque as site of the proposed Marinduque Recreational Center And Sports Arena for twenty five (25) years and maybe renewed for another 25 years after which the ownership of the facility shall be subsequently turned over to second party (see attached copy).

Upon issuance of DENR Administrative Order No. 2016 -21 Sec. 7.3 or the Guidelines "Governing the Processing of Requests for Proclamations And Issuance of Special Patents over Agricultural Lands relative to Section 4 of Republic Act 10023 or "An Act Authority the issuance of free patent to Residential Land "the Municipality of Boac applied for Special Patent title the subject parcel of land to DENR – PENRO (Marinduque) on May 26, 2017 for the issuance of special patent title (see attached copy).

Also attached are the letters inquiring the status of the application for the issuance of special patent title over the said parcel of land and the opposition to the request of Honorable Carmencita Reyes to apply for tenurial instrument the subject area based on the survey order issued by then Asst. Regional Director Vicente B. Tuddoro Jr. including the letter of OIC – PENR officer for a conference between the Municipal Government of Boac and Provincial Government of Marinduque regarding the subject parcel of land.

According to Section 8.3.6 of the same DENR Administrative Order only opposition based on a Certificate of Title duly issued to the oppositors over the same parcel of land shall be given due course. The CENR Office shall refrain from entertaining oppositions based on frivolous claims.

ORDINANCE NO. 95-037

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE CENTRAL PARKING AREAS FOR PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLES, PRESCRIBING RULES, IMPOSING FRES FOR THE USE THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Boac, Marinduque that:

SECTION 1. DECLARATION OF POLICY. The volume of vehicles plying the municipality of Boac poses a major threat on the Government's vision of building an environment conducive to the growth of economic activities within its heart. Clogging/congestions of main thoroughfares have become more visible during the past years and the LGU has to step in to affirm its commitment of providing a sustainable scheme for orderliness which is a pre-condition to progress. It is therefore, the outstanding duty of the Municipal Government to explore all conceivable means to declog the center of the town of excess vehicles and contain them in a central area away from the business center.

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For the purpose of this ordinance, the terms used herein are defined as follows:

- Public Utility Vehicles /PUV/- vehicles plying within the jurisdiction of Boac, Marinduque, notwithstanding its point of origin, providing transport services for a fee either for passengers or cargo. For distinction, PUVs are herein classified as:
 - A. PUJ- this includes all passenger jitneys regardless of size and capacity.
 - B. Delivery vans include vehicles used for deliveries of goods, commodities, other consumer products and other light cargoes not herein enumerated.

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- C. Trucks and Buses include all vehicles within the description of heavy vehicles but not limited to six wheelers, eigth wheelers, ten wheelers and trailers.
- 2. Excess PUV shall be understood as PUVs which can no longer be contained or accommodated in the regular parking areas and PUVs classified b & C under section 2.1 hereof which by reason of their size and load hampers the flow of traffic resulting to clogged streets.
- Regular parking Areas is hereby defined and shall mean as the site/place/area previously designated under ordinance no.
- Peak hours as used herein, shall mean from 6:00 o'clock a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mondays thru Sundays.

SECTION 3. The following areas are hereby designated as Central parking Areas for PUVs.

- a. The eastern portion of the Boac Riverbed, right side of the New Riverside Bridge for excess vehicles falling under the classification A,B & C.
- b. 1 de Nobiembre St. from corner Madrigal to corner Moreno St. for tricycles bound/operating in the riverside zone which are in excess of the number allowed for tricycles to park at the regular parking areas for tricycle as fixed in Section 7.5 hereof.
- c. G. Nieva St. from cor. Moreno St. going to Brgy. Isok for excess tricycles bound for the Seaside Zone.

If Public interest and welfare so requires and for purposes which are of gainful economic and cultural intentions, the Sangguniang Bayan, by resolution, may temporarily lift parking designations herein and relocate parking areas for vehicles covered by this ordinance.

SECTION 4. Imposition of Fees.There is hereby imposed parking fees for the use of parking space at the central parking area at the rates prescribed hereunder.

A. Daytime Parking
Daytime parking means, the use of the space at the parking area from 5:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. or fraction thereof:

SECTION 5. Time and Manner of Payment. The fees imposed herein shall be paid to the Municipal Treasurer or his authorized representative at the time of parking, except for night parking which shall be paid before 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon of the day the parking space shall be used.

Cash ticket shall be issued for payment of parking fees received. Cash tickets issued shall be cancelled by writing on the back thereof the name of the payor, the date of issue and the signature of the collector.

SECTION 6. Surcharge for Late Payment. Failure to pay the fees imposed herein within the time herein required shall subject the driver to a surcharge of twenty-five percent (25%) of the original fees due, such surcharge to be paid at the same time and in the same manner as the original fee.

SECTION 7. Rules and Regulations

- 1. Only five (5) passenger jitneys will be allowed to park at the regular parking areas . All excess PUJs shall park at the Boac Riverbed.
- 2. Delivery vans/jeeps under classification B of Section 2a shall only be allowed to unload at the properly marked and designated unloading areas and in no way shall they be allowed to stay within the poblacion after their deliveries.
- 3. Cargo trucks shall not be allowed to unload/load cargos during peak hours, Monday to Sunday. All cargo trucks shall park at the central parking area designated under section 3a hereof.
- 4. Bus/Buses after unloading passengers shall proceed to the central parking area at the space provided and properly marked for them. The same marked space/area shall be utilized as loading station for passengers.
- 5. (a) seventeen (17) tricycles for the riverside zone shall be allowed to park at Moreno St., from corner Madla's store to police outpost and from corner Magsaysay St., Jr Pharmacy up to corner T. Del Mundo st. Excess thereof shall immediately proceed to the central station designated in section 3 (h) of this ordinance.
- (b) twelve (12) tricycles for the seaside zone shall shall park at the regular parking area and excess thereos (c) hereof.
 - (c) five (5) tricycles each for Poras, Lupac,

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Tabique and Poras, Balogo, Pili shall be allowed to park at their regular parking station and excess thereof shall park at the riverbed.

SECTION 8. Duties of the Municipal Engineer's Office.

- to install all signages for designated unloading areas under strict observance of corner to corner clearance.
- assign sep#rate and distinct parking spaces for passenger jitneys according to point of destination and for trucks, buses and delivery vans at the central parking station.
- initiate proper plans/designs for continuous maintenance and improvement of the central parking areas giving particular attention/concern on orderliness, hygiene, security and lighting.
- SECTION 9. Promulgation of Implementing Rules. The Philippine National Police, Boac Police Command shall after ten (10) days from the date of approval of this ordinance, promulgate the necessary rules and regulations, implementing to the letter, the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 10. Prohibition. Parking of vehicles outside of the parking areas herein designated, exceopt as otherwise provide in this ordinance is strictly prohibited.

SECTION 11 PENALTY. each violation of any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by a fine of not less than one thousand pesos (P 1,000.00) but not more than five thousand pesos (P5,000.00) or by imprisonment of not less than one (1) month nor more than six (6) months or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 12. REPEALING CLAUSE. any ordinance or part or parts thereof which is or are inconsistent with any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed and modified accordingly.

SECTION 13. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. if, for any reason or reasons, any part or parts of this ordinance shall be held to be inconsistent with law or invalid, other part or parts hereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 14.EFFECTIVITY. this ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its publication as mandated in sections 59 and 511 of the LGC and article 114 of the LGC, IRR.

WHEREAS, an area on the said parcel of land, specifically on the western portion of the road leading to Barangay Tabi situated at Barangay Murallon, this municipality, has been difficially declared and is being utilized by the SECOND PARTY as its Central Parking Station by virtue of Municipal Ordinance No. 93-037, a portion within that same area has also been difficially named and declared as "LiwasanngmgaKabataangBoakeño" by virtue of Municipal Ordinance no. 02-077 otherwise known as the Code for Heraldic Items, Local History, Culture and the Arts of 2002 while that same area has been alternately used as the center of some sports activities in the province and in the municipality thereby emphasizing the importance of the same:

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY sharing the goal of the FIRST PARTY has given its consent under the terms and conditions herein agreed and made by both parties;

WHEREAS, both parties are duly authorized by their respective Sanggunian to sign and execute the herein MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT thru appropriate resolutions;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and of the covenants and stipulations becaused set forth and agreed, the parties do hereby agree on the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The SECOND PARTY hereby allows the use and utilization of an area specifically located on the western portion of the road leading to Barangay Tabi situater at Barangay Murallon, this municipalityand as indicated on Annex "C", for the use and utilization of the FIRST PARTY allowing thereby the FIRST PARTY to construct the proposed MARINDUQUE RECREATIONAL CENTER AND SPORTS ARENA on the land area herein described;
- 2. Both parties herein acknowledge that the use and utilization of the aforesaid area as granted by the SECOND PARTY shall be for a period of twenty five (25) years that may be renewed for another period of twenty five (25) years after which the ownership of the facility shall be subsequently turned over to the SECOND PARTY;
- 3. That the Phase One (1) of the design and built construction of the aforesaid facility shall cover the erection of an Olympic Size Track and Field Oval and Grandstand under the budget and full expenditure of the FIRST PARTY pursuant to and in accordance with the general plans and specifications as agreed to by both parties which are herewith attached and marked as Annex "D";
- 4. The SECOND PARTY shall undertake to facilitate the construction of a multi-level parking at the rear portion of the grandstand in accordance with the SITE DEVELOPMENT MASTERPLAN as herein agreed to by both parties;
- 5. Both parties herein acknowledge that future enhancements and future improvements in the afcresaid facility shall be covered by the herein Memorandum of Agreement and shall be based on theagreed SITE DEVELOPMENT MASTERPLAN hereunto attroched, otherwise, improvements and enhancements not covered by the same shall be subject to future negotiations and mutual agreement by both parties. The Site Development Master Plan shall be submitted by the FIRST PARTY conformity of the SECOND PARTY.
- 6. The terms and conditions for the use of the facility shall be based on the following basic principles:

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- 6.1 The management, operation, and maintenance of the Track and Field Oval shall be the responsibility of the FIRST PARTY;

- 6.6 Income derived from the operation of the sports facilities shall be covered by subsequent policies as shall be determined by both parties.





This is to respectfully inform that I strongly opposed the request of Honorable Carmencita O. Reyes as stated in your letter dated June 19, 2017 to apply for tenurial instrument over reclaimed land with an area of 4.3144 hectares and located at Poblacion, Boac, Marinduque.

Likewise, I also strongly opposed the Survey Order issued by Assistant Regional Director Vicente B. Tuddao Jr., instructing your Office to conduct subdivision survey over the said reclaimed land.

For information and as stated in your letter, the Ministry of Natural Resources through the Director of Lands have already approved on May 14, 1985 the Survey Plan to the above mentioned reclaimed land and annotating therein that it was surveyed for the Municipality of Boac as reservation area/municipal park.

As provided under Section 7.3 of DENR Administrative Order No. 2016-21, relative to Section 4 of Republic Act 10023 or **An Act Authorizing the Issuance of Free Patents to Residential Land**, the Municipal Government of Boac had already applied for the issuance of special patent for the subject reclaimed area on May 26, 2017 in your Office to perfect our ownership, but until now no posting of notice was made as provided under Section 8.3.2 of the said DENR Administrative Order.

Please be reminded that according to Section 8.3.6 of the same DENR Administrative Order, only oppositions based on a Certificate of Title duly issued to the oppositors over the same parcel of land shall be given due course.
