Forwarded is the report of CENRO Roxas on the activities conducted on World Wildlife Day. This year's theme is titled "Partners for Wildlife Conservation". The said event held last March 3, 2023 is in celebration of the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES).

The activity highlights the release of three (3) native species: one (1) white-bellied sea eagle and two (2) Philippine long-tailed macaque. The animals were turned over to the office and underwent rehabilitation and monitoring at the Wildlife Rescue Center (WRC). It was observed that the species were in good condition and are now released back into the wild. Attached are the geo-tagged photos and report of the activity.

The 2023 World Wildlife Day is a very special celebration as it marked the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Convention on International Trade in endangered Species of wild Fauna and Flora (CITES), signed on March 3, 1973 in Washington, USA. The United nations General Assembly (UNGA) proclaimed March 3 to celebrate and raise awareness of the world's wild animals and plants.

In line with the celebration, this Office conducted the releasing of one (1) White Bellied Sea Eagle and two (2) Philippine long-tailed Macaque into the wild. The White Bellied Sea Eagle also known as the white-breasted sea eagle is a large diurnal bird of prey in the family Accipitridae, has a white head, breast, under-wing coverts and tail. The Philippine long-tailed Macaque is a subspecies of the crab-eating macaque, known in various Philippine languages as matching/matsing or the more general term unggoy.

The said species was turned over to the office last April 4, 2022 for (1) White Bellied Sea Eagle by Mr. Abner Algipan. For two (1) Philippine long-tailed Macaque last October 26, 2022 by MENRO of Pinamalayan and (1) Philippine long-tailed Macaque last December 13, 2022 by Mr. Ricky Celestial. It undergoes rehabilitation and monitoring at the Wildlife rescue Center (WRC) and observed that it was under good condition thus the Protected Coastal Management Unit decides to release it back in the wild. Health Certification for the release of the said wild animals was given by D and C Animal Clinic issued on March 2, 2023.

This activity was participated by Brgy. Captain Roger Evangelio, Municipal Administration of Bulalacao, Mr. Gideon B. Abuel, Ecosystem Management Especialist I designated as MENRO, Ms. Mafel Myda Y. Gonzales, and assisted by Forster I, Unit Head/Protected Area, Wildlife and Coastal Unit, Ms. Ivy Migzylo E. Macalalag.

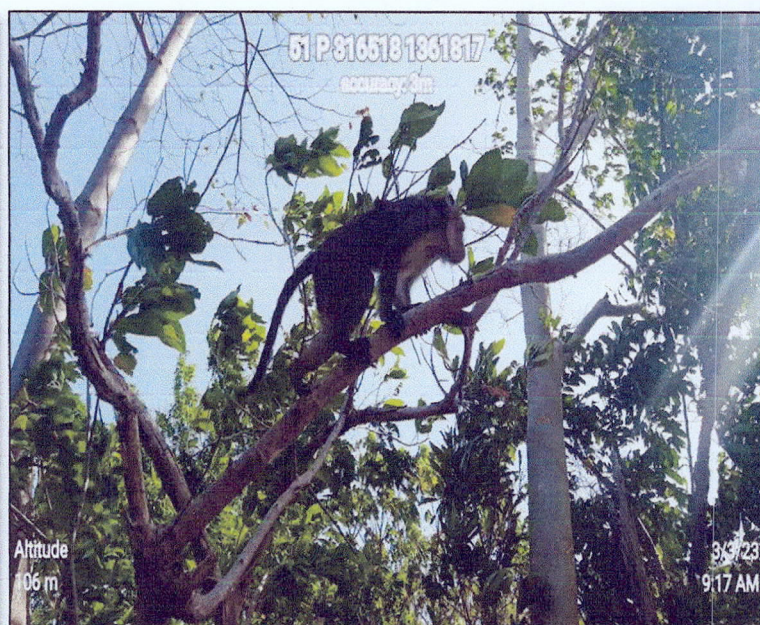
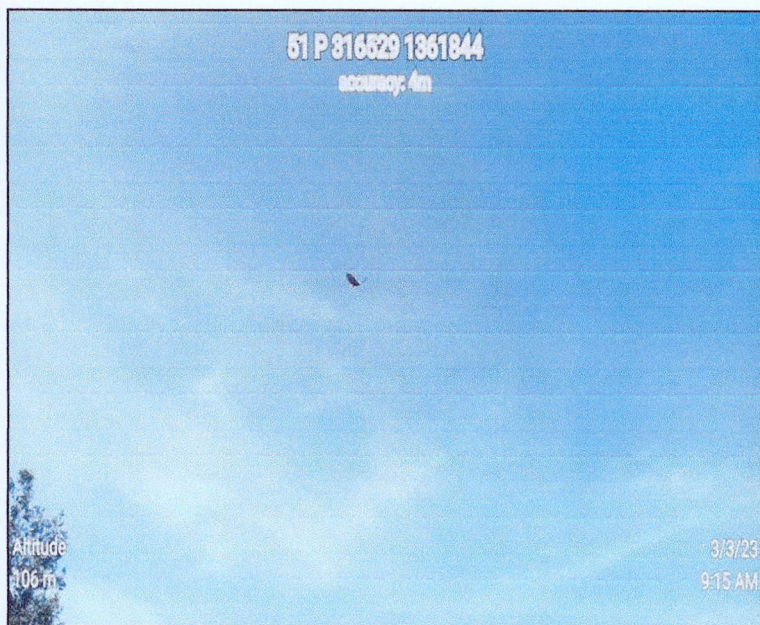

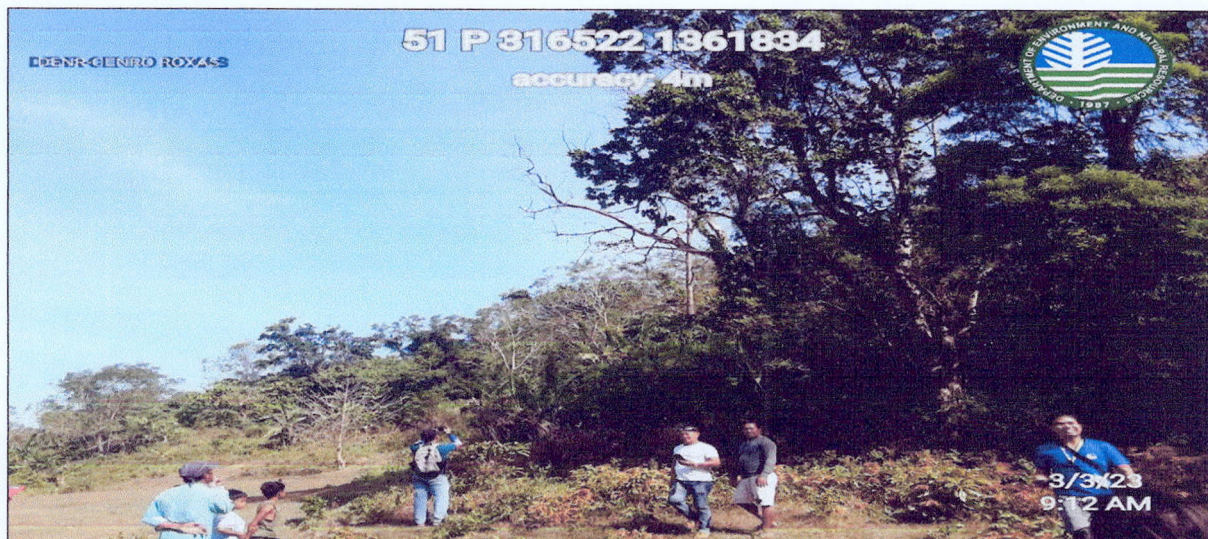
