Please be informed that one (1) dead Green Sea Turtle (*Chelonia mydas*) was found floating in Sitio Albaguen, Barangay Port Barton, San Vicente, Palawan on February 23, 2023. The dead animal's carcass was found in front of Hants Beach by Mr. Mario Ronda and his wife. The couple reported the incident to Port Barton Marine Park (PBMP). The carcass was buried in Sitio Albaguen, Barangay Port Barton, San Vicente, Palawan on the same day (see attached PBMP report and MT02 form).

ONE DEAD GREEN SEA TURTLE REPORTED TO PORT BARTON MARINE PARK

One dead Green Sea Turtle was reported by PBMP Reef Ranger Mario Ronda of Sitio Albaguen, Port Barton, San Vicente, Palawan to the Port Barton Marine Park on February 23, 2023 today at 11:55 in the morning.

The lifeless Green Sea Turtle was found floating in front of Hants Beach, Sitio Albaguen, Port Barton while Mr. Mario Ronda and his wife patrolling in the coast of the island. Seeing the Turtle's condition the said resident reported it immediately in PBMP through a phone call.

Moreover, the Green Sea Turtle has a curved carapace length 33 inches, curved carapace width 23 inches. Estimated died 2 days ago with the possible cause of death drowning or being entangled in fishing net however, the turtle does not possess any wounds in its figure and eyes are reddish. In addition, the Green Sea Turtle is being buried in Sitio Albaguen in between Hants Beach and Betocoper area.

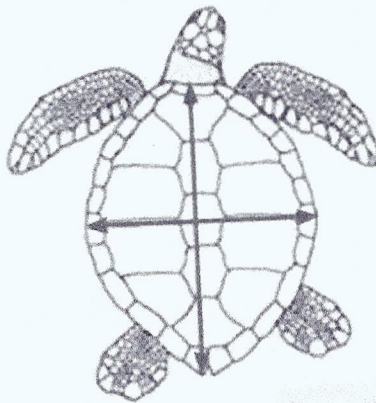
