TORRIJOS, MARINDUQUE

In line with the regular activity under Menu 5: Sustain a well-planned Information, Education and Communications Campaign involvement of forest communities in forest protection of Monitoring and Enforcement Section (MES), submitted herewith is the memorandum report dated 21 February 2023 with enclosures, as output on community meetings conducted on February 08 & 15, 2023 within Barangays Tungib-Lipata, Buenavista and Sibuyao, Torrijos, Marinduque.

A total of Eighty (80) participants from local residents and Sangguniang Barangay officials attended/ participated in the said meetings.

Prior to the conduct of CEPA, advanced coordination through concerned barangay officials. The topics relevant to environmental laws were discussed such as: Chainsaw Act of 2002 (RA 9175), Forestry Reform Code of the Philippines (PD 705), Declaring a Moratorium on the Cutting and Harvesting of Timber in Residual Forest and Creating Anti-Illegal Logging Task Force (EO 23), Wildlife Resources Conservation and Protection Act (RA 9147) and ten (10) priority programs of DENR, and different frontline services such as permits issuance. The Magna Carta of Women (RA 9710) was also highlighted. Flyers/reading materials on forestry laws were also given to the participants.

CONDUCTED IN BARANGAY SIBUYAO, TORRIJOS,

MARINDUQUE ON FEBRUARY 15, 2023

In compliance with the target for CY 2023 under 5.1 Involvement of Forest Communities in forest protection works, please be informed that on February 15, 2023 Monitoring and Enforcement Section conducted Communication, Education, Public Awareness (CEPA) in Barangay Sibuyao, Torrijos, Marinduque.

The activity was held at the Barangay Hall of Barangay Sibuyao Torrijos, Marindoque last February 8, 2023 at 10:30 in the morning. The activity was started with an opening prayer followed by the singing of the National Anthem. Welcome message was delivered by Barangay Councilor Jocelyn L. Landoy of Barangay Sibuyao, Torrijos, Marinduque designated by the Barangay Captain due to conflict of schedule.

The first topics that were discussed are the Legal Basis and Definitions of Gender and Development, and the Magna Carta of Women (RA 9710) presented by Ms. Sarah Jane L. Montalban, GAD Focal Officer. The presenter explained to the participants the current situation regarding the issues on the rights and roles of woman in nation building.

The second topic was the Ecological Solid Waste Management otherwise known as Republic Act. No. 9003, presented by Jonathan Motol and Michelle Macariola of Environmental Management Bureau embedded at PENRO Marinduque. They discussed the Implementing Rules and Regulations and the duties and functions of each individual and organization in the community.

The final topic that was presented is about the Current Status of Philippine Forest, Revised Forestry Code of the Philippines otherwise known as Presidential Decree No. 705, Executive Order No. 23 -Declaring Moratorium on the Cutting and Harvesting of Timber in the Natural and Residual Forests and the Creation of Anti-Illegal Logging Tasks Force and other pertinent laws. Accomplishment of National Greening Program (NGP) and the Enhanced National Greening Program (eNGP) were discussed by Forester Joybert F. Mijares. He also explained the Basic Forestry Law, Cutting Permits, Chainsaw registration and the penalties when violations are committed.

After the presentation, it was followed by an open forum facilitated by Forester Bernadine Jasul. The participants raised some issues and concern such as; 1.) Application of cutting permit 2.) Requirements of the cutting permits and the registration of Chainsaw. All issues and concern regarding permitting and issuances was explained thoroughly by Team lead by For. Mijares who answered all the questions raised by the participants.

A total of forty (40) participants, ten (10) male and thirty (30) female participated in the said meeting, and flyers regarding the Magna Carta of Women, CEPA flyers and posters were distributed to the said participants

Further, the team distributed Informative flyers and posters regarding environmental laws, conservation and protection of our natural resources including wildlife.

FOREST NARRATIVE REPORT RE: INVOLVEMENT OF WORKS CONDUCTED IN BARANGAY TUNGIB-LIPATA, BUENAVISTA,

MARINDUQUE ON FEBRUARY 08, 2023

In compliance with the target for CY 2023 under 5.1 Involvement of Forest Communities in forest protection works, please be informed that on February 08, 2023 DENR-PENRO Marinduque thru the Technical Services Division's Monitoring and Enforcement Section conducted Communication, Education, Public Awareness (CEPA) in Barangay Tungib-Lipata, Buenavista, Marinduque.

The activity was held at the open court of Barangay Tungib-Lipata Buenavista, Marinduque last February 8, 2023 at 9:30 in the morning. The activity started by an opening prayer followed by singing of National Anthem. Welcome message was delivered by Barangay Councilor Randy R. Valencia of Barangay Tungib-Lipata, Buenavista, Marinduque. He was designated by the Barangay Captain for health reason.

The first topics that were discussed are the Legal Basis and Definitions of Gender and Development, and the Magna Carta of Women (RA 9710) presented by Ms. Sarah Jane L. Montalban, GAD Focal Officer. The presenter explained to the participants the current situation regarding the issues on the rights and roles of women in nation building.

The next topic is the features of Marinduque Wildlife Sanctuary presented by Forester Glaiza M. Peñaflorida of the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO). She discussed the importance and roles of Marinduque Wildlife Sanctuary in terms of ecosystem services, the importance why it needs to be regulated and protected, the cultural, and other services that protected area provides not only to the nearby communities but to the whole province of Marinduque. She also mentioned the challenges that the PAMO is facing in managing and protecting the MWS. It was further explained Section 20 of Expanded National Integrated Protected Area System (ENIPAS) and other different prohibited acts of the said RA. Also, she discussed Conservation and Protection of Wildlife otherwise known as Republic Act No. 9147.

Mr. Ronald M. Matining of the National Greening Program (NGP) explained the program and reminded the participants in their role on the project that was implemented in Barangay Tungib-Lipata. Mr. Matinig further explained that the program was intended to them and they should also help protect and maintain the area.

The final topic presented was about the Current Status of Philippine Forest, Revised Forestry Code of the Philippines otherwise known as Presidential Decree No. 705, Executive Order No. 23 -Declaring Moratorium on the Cutting and Harvesting of Timber in the Natural and Residual Forests and the Creation of Anti-Illegal Logging Tasks Force and other pertinent laws. Accomplishment of the National Greening Program (NGP) and the Enhanced National Greening Program (eNGP) were discussed by Forester Joybert F. Mijares. He also explained the Basic Forestry Law, Cutting Permits, Chainsaw registration and the penalties when violations are committed.

After the presentation, it was followed by an open forum facilitated by Forester Bernadine Jasul. The participants provided some issues and concern and the team provided them with all the answers and solutions regarding tree cuttings, renewal of chainsaw and the proper disposal of solid waste. Other issues that were raised are the; 1.) Possibility of community engagement in the seedling production as part of their livelihood and for them to earn additional income; 2.) Issue on the political boundary conflicts in the area. For. Mijares explained that the willingness of the community to produce seedlings is very much welcome. The team encouraged them to proceed with their plan to produce seedlings and promised them to provide technical assistance if requested. This initiative by the community will limit other members of the community to engage in illegal activities like charcoal making which is accordingly is rampant in the area. For the boundary conflict, the participants were informed that political boundary conflict can only be resolved between the two barangays in conflict through the intercession of the municipal LGU of Buenavista together with the DENR-PENRO Marinduque and the NAMRIA.

A total of forty (40) participants, twenty-two (22) male and nineteen (19) female participated in the said meeting. Different CEPA/IEC materials regarding ENR Laws were distributed, including flyers on Magna Carta of Women.
