HIGHLIGHTS

Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) seeks to conserve the remaining forest through protection, reforestation of denuded areas, assisted natural regeneration (ANR) of remaining forest, and secure the protection and maintenance of planted trees.

The Forest Protection project also aims to achieve the following:

- (1) Compliance with the JVA requirements;
- (2) Strengthening existing collaboration(s) with the MENRO, PCSD, DENR, Municipal LGU, and Local Government Units (LGU) of Ransang and Candawaga, Rizal and other local communities and partners especially with the protection and reforestation of the denuded forest;
 - (3) Supporting the National Greening Program of the Government (NGP);
- (4) Further enhancement of the awareness and capabilities of the local communities in the protection, reforestation of denuded forest and establishment of endemic fruits & trees, and high value fruit tree plantation;
- (5) Effective mobilization of local communities towards the protection of the remaining forest and establishment of high value fruit tree plantation; and
- (6) help improve the living condition of IP's and non-IPs through the promotion of raising the indigenous tree and fruit tree seedlings.



For this month of December 2022, the Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) has accomplished the following activities:

- a. Last December 2022, Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) continued conducting Seedlings Care and Maintenance activities such as watering, weeding, re-bagging of seedlings, application of organic foliar fertilizer and pesticide. The total remaining seedlings stocks in Forest Nursery is Twelve Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-Two (12,842) seedlings.
- b. Last December 2022, Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) the nursery worker continued conducting collecting of Mahogany (<u>Swietenia</u> <u>macrophylla</u>) wildlings to complete the target of the company in tree plantation. The total collected Mahogany wildlings for the month of december was Eight Hundred (800) wildlings. (*Please see photos* attached as ANNEX A)
- c. Last December 2022, Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) Foot Patrol Unit continued conducting regular monitoring of illegal activities inside the JVA and adjacent areas. Based on the report made by the Foot Patrol Unit, for the month of December the team roamed and observed the different areas that there is no trace of Illegal activities in the vicinity and neighbors of the Lionheart areas. This is the result of the continued conduct of Information Education Campaign (IEC) of the company and hiring of persons involved in the illegal activity.

The continue bad weather condition damaged the coconut plantation like uprooted the planted palm, felled, broke the branches and fell with trees. (Please see photos attached as ANNEX B)

d. Last December 2022, Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) planters team continued conducting land preparation, collection & hauling of stake, alignment and sticking, holing, hauling and planting of wildlings.

The LFPC planters team accomplished the alignment and sticking with a total number of One Thousand Six Hundred Fifty (1,650) pieces of sticks installed at the planting site. (Please see photos attached as ANNEX C)



e. Last December 2022, Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) the planters continued conducting planting of Mahogany (<u>Swietenia macrophylla</u>) wildlings in the said areas. The total planted Mahogany (<u>Swietenia macrophylla</u>) for this month was Two Thousand Fifty Nine (2,059) wildlings located at Upper Malutok, Ransang, Rizal, Palawan.
