REPORT ON THE ATTENDED TRAINING OF TRAINERS (TOT) FOR THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG) OF SIBOL COMMUNITY MANAGED SAVINGS AND CREDIT ASSOCIATION (COMSCA)

Community Managed Savings and Credit Association (CoMSCA) is a community-based group that mobilizes and manages its own savings. By conducting the training of trainers, SIBOL aims to fulfill its vision of developing cadres of CoMSCA that will sustain the gains of the savings movement in Puerto Princesa City and in the Province of Palawan and provide skills on facilitation, formation, monitoring and support of new groups of CoMSCA.

The Training of Trainers (TOT) for CoMSCA was conducted on January 25-27, 2023 at the City State Asturias Hotel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan. It a 3-day training composed of nine (9) modules and a site visit to one of the CoMSCA in Barangay Binduyan, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan.

Participants of the TOT for CoMSCA from this office is composed of the undersigned, Planning Officer II Myra Mapanao, ECOMS I Lauri Rose Coquia and Information Officer Irene Mixdon. It was also participated by different partner agencies such as the City Government of Puerto Princesa (City ENRO & City Tourism Office), Barangay LGUs of Panggangan, Marufinas, Tanabag, Tagabinet and Binduyan, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan, staff from the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) of Puerto Princesa Subterranean River National Park (PPSRNP), as well as representative from CENRO Puerto Princesa City.

Highlights of the Training

Day 1 (January 25, 2023) of the training starts with the registration of the participants followed by the opening program, then levelling off and expectation setting for the 3-day training. Levelling off and expectation setting for resource speakers, topics, logistics and coparticipants includes the following:

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After the expectation setting and levelling off, the facilitator discussed the schedule of the training and its objectives. Then followed by the discussion of the Concept of savings, CoMSCA Delivery, its concepts and methodology.

After the first three (3) topics, it was followed by the discussion of CoMSCA standards which covers the creation of Management Committee and its responsibilities, meeting flow, duration and schedule, fines, seating arrangement, loans and disbursement, share purchase/savings/and the organization of CoMSCA. Then after the discussion of CoMSCA standards, the participants practice the said standards through a role playing activities such as the election/ formation of CoMSCA Management Committee.

During the afternoon session in Day 1, Module 1 : Groups, Leadership and Election and Module 2: Development of Policies and Rules for Social Fund, Share Purchase and Credit Activities were discussed.



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Day 2

For Day 2, topics discussed were the following: Module 3: Development of Group Constitution; Module 4: Record Keeping and How to Manage a Savings Meeting; Module 5: First Share Purchase/Savings Meeting; Module 6: First Loan Disbursement Meeting; Module 7: First Loan Repayment Meeting; Module 8: Daily Slot Savings; Module 9: Share-out/Action Audit.

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Day 3

For the 3rd day of the training, the participants went to Barangay Binduyan, Puerto Princea City, Palawan to observe an actual CoMSCA meeting in the said barangay. The CoMSCA group formed in Barangay Binduyan is in their 2nd cycle. After their meeting, the participants has been given a chance to ask questions to the CoMSCA members. Questions raised were the following: (1) what were the advantages of being a CoMSCA member and how does it help them and their family; (2) what is the impact of CoMSCA to them and their family in terms of savings and budgeting; (3) Where did they spent/used the money they borrowed/loaned. Most of the CoMSCA members used the borrowed/loaned money for their basic needs.

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After the site visit, the participants went back to Asturias Hotel to finish the remaining lectures and conducted a re-entry planning for CoMSCA formulation within their respective jurisdiction. Then it was followed by the closing ceremony, wherein the participants received their certificates.
