PENRO ROMBLON'S YEAR END ASSESSMENT cum CHRISTMAS PARTY CY 2022

December 15, 2022 Lyn's Fern Garden. Brgy. Budiong, Odiongan, Romblon

Brief Introduction

The Year- End Assessment is an annual activity of PENRO Romblon where every section including Enhanced National Greening Program, as the banner program of the DENR presents their annual accomplishments based on their annual targets. Customary, the Year- End Assessment was attended by all personnel and staffs of PENRO Romblon (Tablas and Sibuyan-based).

Highlights of the Activity

Part I- Preliminaries

On 15 December 2022, the registration and arrival of the participants started around 7:30 am until 8:30 am. This was followed by an Opening Prayer and Singing of Lupang Hinirang. Next, Chief MSD Thelmo S. Hernandez gave his Welcome Remarks wherein he first roll- called all the participants and asked them to greet each other a 'Merry Christmas'. According to him, we should think of the best practices that we should maintain and to be innovative over it. MSD Hernandez was glad that PENRO Romblon had become proactive and innovative toward work. He ended his message by a phrase "Let us move in one direction, and that direction is forward". After the Welcome Remarks was the Inspirational Message delivered by OIC, PENRO Arnoldo A. Blaza, Jr. He acknowledged the effort and hardwork of everyone, that despite of some unavoidable circumstances, PENRO Romblon had successfully accomplished all the targets for this calendar year.

To continue with the program, another message was given by the OIC Chief of Planning Section, Forester II Sheilla Jane M. Forlales. According to her, aside from figures and percentage of accomplishments, it is also important to state, during the presentation of each section, the issues and challenges encountered that caused delay in the implementation of some target activities of the Office.

Part II- Presentation of Physical Target versus Accomplishment 2022

The first presenter was the Chief of Regulation and Permitting Section (RPS), Sir Allan T. Sendiong. He admitted that this year was very challenging for them. But through the contribution and dedication of their team members, they were able to accomplished all their targets. In fact, some of the targets such as Issuance of Cutting/ Harvesting Permits and Wood Processing Permits, conduct of continuing inventory of Water Resources, conduct of identification and mapping of Water Sources, and Survey of Residential Areas were

accomplished beyond the targets. TSD Chief Malvin R. Rocero reminded the Planning Section to make sure that the Means of Verifications (MOVs) per activity were already submitted to the Regional Office.

The next presenter was the current PASu of Calsanag Watershed Forest Reserve and a representative from *Coastal and Development Section (CDS)*, EcoMS II Raymund G. Inocencio. As presented, all target activities were fully accomplished and Sir Inocencio made sure that all reports were submitted to Regional Office on time.

After the presentation, CDS Chief Arlyn D. Balibag extended her sincere gratitude to everyone who became part of the accomplishment of Coastal and Development Section.

The presentation for the *Enhanced National Greening Program (ENGP) Unit* was delivered by Forester I Catherine O. Atienza. As stated, all target activities were also fully accomplished including the Establishment of Forest Nursery which was currently under construction and expected to be accomplished on 21 December 2022. Just like other presenters, Forester Atienza also acknowledged the contribution and dedication of the whole team of NGP unit. She also thanked Forester Manuel B. Romero, the former NGP Coordinator, for his continuous support and assistance in the implementation of target activities.

Next was the presentation of the *Monitoring and Enforcement Section (MES)* which was given by Forester II James Mendoza. He also thanked those who contributed to the accomplishment of MES, both from Tablas and Sibuyan Sub-Station. According to Forester Mendoza, all targets were accomplished except the Hiring of Legal Researcher with the remarks 'No Interested'. OIC PENRO Blaza, Jr. emphasized that the patrol reports were to be submitted monthly and that they have to identify the number of threats during the patrolling. At the end of the presentation, Forester Mendoza stated the issues and concerns they have experienced throughout the year such as: insufficient number of Forest Rangers and Forest Protection Officers to patrol and guard the forest land resources in the entire province of Romblon; the need of logistic support to enforcement and campaign against illegal environmental activities; and the budget allocation for the intensive IEC campaign to the remote barangays of this province.

Another presentation was given by Forester III Manuel B. Romero, the PASu of *Mt. Guiting- Guiting Natural Park (MGGNP)*. As per presentation, all their target activities were accomplished except the maintenance of seven (7) facilities which were still on- going activities and were expected to accomplished before the end of the year. In the course of presentation, TSD Chief Rocero said that the last submission of all MOVs and Vouchers must be on 16 December 2022.

The next presenter was from *Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB)*, Engr. Carl Felix Falquerabao. He said, this year was very challenging for him due to multiple concerns and issues he received especially with Altai Philippines Mining Corporation (APMC). In spite of

those, he was able to respond and provide technical assistance to all concerned. He also extended his genuine gratitude for the unwavering support of OIC PENRO Blaza, TSD Malvin, and personnel of Sibuyan Sub-Station for their extended assistance.

Afterwards, was the presentation from the Chief of *Admin and Finance Section*, Accountant III Florence Grace F. Domingo. According to her, to date, CNA has already been given, whereas SRI and Gratuity pay were still pending, since there is no approval given yet from the Central Office. Accountant Domingo presented the summary of Status of Fund Utilization (current and continuing appropriation) as of December 15, 2023. As per presentation, in Forest Development, Rehabilitation, Maintenance and Protection, there is total allotment of 3,294,349.30, obligations incurred 3,180,315.72, and unobligated balance of 39,033.58.

Meanwhile, TSD Chief Rocero said that in relation to backlogs for inspection, members of inspection committee in Sibuyan, must stay in PENRO Romblon until Monday (December 19, 2022) until all need to be accomplished were accomplished.

Next activity was the *Critiquing and Comments* from the top-level management. Firstly, MSD Chief Hernandez gave special thanks to procurement team, particularly the Technical Working Group and the Bidding and Awards Committee (BAC) secretariat Forester Vanessa Gadon. "Hopefully, we keep an eye to our partially accomplished/ongoing target activities", Mr. Hernandez enthused. Secondly, TSD Chief Rocero thanked TSD staffs for all their supports since he became in-charged of TSD Office. He hoped by next year their performance will be better. He also extended his appreciation to MSD for their support for the last five months (January- June) of staying at MSD Office. He knew that all personnel gave their best. He also thanked personnel from Sibuyan for coming to the event. Lastly, OIC PENRO Blaza persuaded all personnel to develop the teamwork. He said, next year, they will do different/ with better strategies, and they will do the weekly monitoring.

Then, the *Awarding of Certificates* to officials and staffs namely: Regulation and Permitting Section (RPS), Monitoring and Enforcement Section (MES), Conservation and Development Section (CDS), Enhanced National Greening Program (eNGP), Sibuyan Sub-Station/PA-MGGNP, Administrative and Finance Section, and Planning and ICT Section.

In conjunction of the activity was the short program prepared for the two honored retirees-- Cartographer Leni L. Ferry and Park Maintenance Foreman Romeo S. Contaoi. Appreciations and thanksgiving from colleagues who were very close to them were uttered. The retirees were also given a chance to express their gratitude to the DENR-PENRO Romblon family. After that, a dedication song was sung, while others giving hugs and flowers to the two amazing personnel who also became their fathers, friends, and co-employees for many years.

Part III- Christmas Party 2022

Everyone was excited for the last part of the program, the PENRO Romblon 2022 Christmas Party. Bringing with them their presents wrapped with DIY indigenous Christmas wrappers like dried leaves, recycled papers and materials, and abacca.

The program started with a Short Prayer, an Opening Remarks and Inspirational Message from the top management. This was followed by presentations (song and dance) of every Section. Next, was the judging of the DIY indigenous Christmas wrapped gifts which was the highlight of the activity. The judges chose the top three (3) winners and were given prizes. Consolation prizes (load cards) were given to the non- winning entries.

Then, the exchange gift with a twist followed. While forming a circle, everyone sung "Pasko na Naman", and whenever "pasko" was mentioned, participants passed their gift to the person next to them. Then, the Raffle Draw was enjoyed by everyone especially those who luckily got major prizes. After that, was the family dinner.






