The activities conducted for the said monitoring for this quarter include:

- 1. Inventory of existing wildlife species in the WRC facilities turnover
- 2. Regular monitoring of health status of each wildlife species in the center
- 3. Turnover of two (2) species of Philippine Long-tailed Macaque (Macaca fascicularis philippensis) and one (1) species of White-Bellied Sea Eagle (Haliaeetus leucogaster)
- 4. Medical check-up and inspection of the three (3) turned over species
- 5. Release of the three (3) species into the wild with certification of fair medical condition

Submitted is the Quarterly Monitoring Report of CENRO Roxas, Oriental Mindoro on the Management of Wildlife Rescue Center (WRC) facilities under Wildlife Sub-Programs. Submitted is the report of the monitoring activity in the Wildlife Rescue Center (WRC) of CENRO Roxas, Oriental Mindoro.

The Wildlife Rescue Center (WRC) of DENR Oriental Mindoro is located in Sitio Banti, Barangay San Roque, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro was regularly monitored by this Office. As part of the monitoring activity, the Coastal and Wildlife Unit personnel of CENRO conducted inventory on the existing wildlife species in the center due to additional species turned over to the office. The monitoring of health status of wildlife species was regularly undertaken. Moreover, the WRC was visited by PENRO Allan L. Valle, TSD Chief, Alma E. Gibe, Planning Officer Corazon Pudiquet and CENRO Caesar E. Quebec. The activity was part of the monitoring on the implemented DENR Plans and Programs.

Recently, as part of the celebration of World Wildlife Day, this office released three (3) wildlife species into the wild. The species were Philippine Long-tailed Macaque and White Belled-Sea Eagle. The Philippine Long-tailed Macaque (*Macaca fascicularis philippensis*) was turn over by MENRO of Bulalacao last October 2022 and the other one was turn over by Mr. Ricky Celestial last December 2022 while the White Belled-Sea Eagle (*Haliaeetus leucogaster*) was turn over by Mr. Abner Algipan last April 2022. Furthermore, the above-mentioned species undergo check-up and inspection by a resident Animal Doctor and signifies certificate of health status before it was released back into the wild. The released activity was successful with the assistance of LGU Bulalacao (Municipal Administrator and MENR Office) and Barangay Officials, Councils and community residence of Sitio Puting Bato, Barangay Maujao where the released activity was conducted.






