I. INTRODUCTION

The Community-Based Forest Management (CBFM) is the national strategy for the sustainable development of the country's forest resources and social justice Pursuant to Executive Order No. 236 and Department Administrative Order (DAO) 96-29.

The Community Based Forest Management (CBFM) is the national strategy for the sustainable development of the country's forest resources. This program aims to promote the socio- economic upliftment of forest communities and achieving sustainable development and management of forest resources.

It recognizes the responsible and efficient utilization by organized and empowered local communities based on sound ecological and economic principles can result to sustainable management of forestlands and resources.

The periodic monitoring aims to know the status of the DENR-CARP Projects and other related CBFM activities within their respective areas in compliance with the existing rules and regulations, progress in terms of area development, organizational development and project implementation.

Part of the technical assistance provided to the CBFM partners during the periodic monitoring and assessment is the conduct of a small group of meeting with some BODs members of the association purposely to determine the extent of development undertaken within their respective CBFM areas. The result of the information provided during the meeting including the onsite monitoring and assessment will be the basis in providing them effective recommendations towards sustainable development management of their CBFM areas.

II. LEGAL BASIS

- 1. Under Executive Order No. 263, the Community Based Forest Management is a national Strategy to ensure sustainable development of the Country's Forestland Resources and providing mechanism for its implementation. Thus, the DENR is mandated to work with Local Government Units (LGUs), People's Organizations (Pos), Non-Government Organizations (NGOs), Religious Groups, Business and Industry sectors and other concerned organizations to ensure that communities are empowered to initiate and achieve the objectives of this Order (Section No. 6)
- 2. FMB Technical Bulletin No. 20 and Section 18 of DAO 2004-29, also indicates that the CRMF is a strategic plan of the community on how to manage and benefit from the forest resources on a sustainable basis. It describes the community's long term vision, aspirations, commitments, and strategies for the protection, rehabilitation, development, and utilization of forest resources. The CRMF shall provide specific activities for the first five (5) years, which shall serve as the Five Year Work Plan of the Peoples Organization.

PROGRESS REPORT

The Palbong CBFM Association, Inc. is registered at the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) on January 7, 1999 under SEC Registration No. A199815108. A Community Based Forest Management (CBFMA) issued by the Regional Office in February 7, 1999 and to expire on February 7, 2024 under CBFMA Registration No. RIV-OCCMIN-CBFMA 2000-05 with 71 registered members.

In CY 2020, the CENRO Sablayan GIS Personnel conducted re-survey the 628.9 hectares awarded to Palbong CBFM Association, Inc. Based on the actual ground verification survey, the CADT of Alangan Mangyan is no longer overlapped with this CBFMA. (Please see attached digitized map for your reference.)

The re-survey team submitted GIS maps in accordance with the FMB Technical Bulletin No. 21-A also known as the guidelines in the Assessment, Re-survey and Mapping of areas covered by CBFMA and other Tenure Agreement.

The livelihood adopted by the community was per household basis like planting of cash crops, banana, corn, rice, camote, coffee, gabi and cassava among others. This community is recipient of livelihood program under CARP fund. Previous livelihood opportunities such as hog raising, cattle raising are found to be very



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helpful for the family of each active member of the community. For 2021, the CBFM-CARP funded their Rattan-Based Agro-forestry Development Project (seedling production, nursery establishment and plantation establishment)

Activities in preparation of Community Resource Management Framework (CRMF) was conducted, formulated and for affirmation of the RED. Also, the Five Year Work Plan (FYWP) was already signed by the PENR Officer and was attached on the submitted CRMF at the Regional Office.

A refresher course regarding simple book keeping and accounting to both CBFM members and front liners was already conducted during the Organizational Development Skills Enhancement of CBFM Pos held on July 13-14, 2021 at Aroma Hotel and Resort Complex, Barangay San Roque, San Jose Occidental Mindoro
