




PATROL COVERAGE AND INTENSITY




Location of observed threats



Kasuyan Brgy. Nicolas – So. Tadlok Brgy. Alibog, Magsaysay and 7.43 km at So. Kalinisan Brgy. Bayotbot and 6.21 km in Brgy. Labangan Ilin – Brgy. Ansiray Ilin Island respectively in San Jose Occidental Mindoro. A total of (2) threats observed/encountered; (1) Cutting of Trees and (1) Slash and Burn/Kaingin (158) forest condition recorded. 







This reports presents trends in observations of forest condition, regeneration, threats and indicator species. The combined presentation allows for an evaluation if protection efforts are effective, conservation targets are met and the forest achieves the desired future forest condition. Protection efforts are effective, when records of forest condition, regeneration and indicator species show an upward trend towards more observations more and denser regeneration, particularly in degraded forest areas. Increasing trends in indicator species suggest that the improved forest condition is providing a better habitat for forest dependent species. All trends presented are put in relation to the patrol effort to provide comparability. Forest cover data were derived from 2003 and 2010 NAMRIA land cover maps.


Trends of Observations per Patrol Kilometer in the Forest Conservation Area
