On February 21, 2023, the DENR Oriental Mindoro thru PENRO Planning Section conducted Stakeholders Consultation Meeting on DENR Plans and Programs for the province of Oriental Mindoro held at Seacliff Suites Hotel and Resort, Brgy. Zone III, Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro.

The meeting was attended by the DENR key personnel, Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO) staff/representatives, People's Organizations (CBFMA POs), NGP partners, FLAg Holder staff/representative and also from the Philippine National Police.

The consultation meeting aims to promote transparent, accountable and participatory planning among DENR stakeholders and collective initiatives for the conservation, management, utilization and protection of the provinces' environment and natural resources. The PENRO thru the Planning Section conducted the Stakeholders Consultation Meeting on DENR Plans and Programs for FY 2023 on February 21, 2023 at Seacliff Hotel Suites and Resort, Brgy. Zone III, Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro

Preliminary activities such as Prayer and singing the Philippine National Anthem were undertaken thru AVP.

IEC Officer Bea Natasha Fortu the facilitator of the meeting let the participants introduce themselves.

PENRO Alan L. Valle acknowledged, welcomed and thanked all stakeholders for attending the meeting. Most of the attendees were from the PNP, MENRO of the different municipalities and NGP partners, CBFMA holders, tenurial instrument holders and from the DENR stakeholder/partners.

The meeting proceeded by presenting the DENR Mandates, Vission and Mission including the Province's ENR Profile presented by PO I Engr. Jezreel John Matre. He discussed thoroughly the Mandates, Vision and Mission, Goals and Objectives of the department as well as the Province's Environment and Natural Resources statistics. After the presentation, the participants were asked for their queries or clarifications.

Mr. Armando Bae, Jr. of ORMIN, Power, asked why the Municipality of San Teodoro was not mentioned in the Provincial Profile for tourism whereas, San Teodoro was the so called heaven of water falls in Oriental Mindoro and also the caves were not mentioned.

Ms. Joan Yap, MENRO of the municipality of Pto. Galera also commented why the Municipality of Pto. Galera was not also included in the Provincial Profile given the Puerto Galera was known as the Marine Biosphere.

Ms. Bea Fortu agreed that Pto. Galera must be given more importance in the conservation and management program as it is one of the major key Biodiversity Areas and being one of the recognized tourist destination in Oriental Mindoro. She also explained that DENR is still on process of inventory of caves but she promised that the caves will be included in the list of promotion areas for tourism.

Ms. Theresa Valera, MENRO of the Municipality of Gloria, clarified the presented data of the total land area of the municipality of Gloria. SVMS Amor A. Asi explained that in the formulation of FLUP, the area to be used depends on the agreement between the DENR and LGU during the formulation. PO I Jeck Matre added that the area presented was based from the Oriental Mindoro Facts and Figurest of the Province published by the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro. PENRO Valle added that the data must be based from the approved Cadastral Survey which is the official land area.

CENRO Rodel M. Boyles of CENRO Socorro clarified the query of Mr. Bae of ORMIN Power regarding the inclusion of the waterfalls and caves within the municipality of San Teodoro in the Province's ENR Profile. He advised the LGU to send a letter request to DENR for assistance in the identification and inventory of such areas to be developed for tourism purposes.

The second presenter was PO II Nestor Mira, Jr. He presented the ENR Medium Term Plan. Afterwards, he asked the participants for any queries and clarifications.

Atty. Michael Cerisa, LGU of Gloria, asked if DENR has a working relationship with NCIP? PO II Nestor Mira replied that when it comes to the implementation of projects, there is a Memorandum of Agreement between DENR and NCIP.

CENRO Boyles clarified that when it comes to the determination of ancestral domain, the DENR has no control to the extent of it. The NCIP have their own process on how to validate the ancestral domain area.

CENRO Boyles stressed that since there is no registered Certificate of Title for the IPs in the Register of Deeds, the existing law will prevail regarding ancestral domain. The DENR shall coordinate with the NCIP whenever there is a project to be implemented inside the ancestral domain.

PENRO Valle further explained that there is no conflict in the implementation of the law because the NCIP claimed their ownership while DENR is for the conservation and protection. So there is no conflict. He also explained that under the IPRA law if we issued permit we need the consent from the NCIP for which we need to follow. The relationship of the two has no overlapping, since we have a Joint Administrative Order (JAO) which is NAMRIA, DAR, and DENR there is no overlapping.

A FLAG holder in Puerto Galera, asked if in case the tenured land area falls on CADT/CADC area do they pay the rental for forestland? because there is something conflict between the IPs. He stated that they cannot prohibited the IPs on their cultural activities.

CENRO Boyles explained that the payment was based on a tenure agreement given. He advised that since, there is a tenure and the CADC was not yet approved, maybe they can

still paid for the government. He added, that on the next payment if the CADC was already approved they can set an agreement/policies for them to follow.

MENRO Yap asked: What is the authority over the land on the recognition of the CADC of NCIP sa area ng FLAG?

CENRO Boyles explained that they should continue on the processing of their application of land title. He also explained that for claiming the ownership, it should be supported with documents, otherwise it will honor by the state. They still have to provide a concrete proof of ownership.

Mr. Bae of ORMIN Power, asked :If we re-route/rehabilitate can we violate the FLAG agreement?

CENRO Boyles suggested that they shall coordinate and present their plans with the CENRO for them to explain all the details.

On the afternoon, the Chief, Planning Section PO III Corazon E. Pudiquet presented the FY 2023 Thrust and Direction in the FY 2023 Work and Financial Plan of the province. She discussed the priority programs of DENR under the present administration of Secretary Loyzaga. She informed the participants to prepare their inputs and recommendations, programs to be include in the programs/projects of DENR.

To further enhance the knowledge of the participants regarding DENR Services the following personnel presented the following:

Mr. Peterson F. Fabellon - Forestry
Ms. Bonz Culla-Umali - Lands
Mr. Mackaley Martinez - Wildlife

Chief, RPS of CENRO Roxas LMO II Peterson Fabellon presented the Tree Cutting Permits and Regulations.

Ms. Bonz Culla-Umali, Chief RPS of CENRO Socorro presented and discussed the Requirements on the Patent Issuance. She thoroughly explained all the procedures and requirements on the application of Agricultural and Residential Free Patent.

Forester I Mackaley Martinez Planning Officer of CENRO Socorro also presented and discussed regarding Wildlife Permit Issuances and requirements.

After all the presentation, Ms. Bea Fortu announced the open forum to discuss and clarifies the issues and concerns.

MENRO Mafel Myda Gonzales of the Municipality of Bulalacao inquired on how to avail permit/register chainsaw for the use of LGU in MDRRMO.

CENRO Boyles clarified that based on the Chainsaw Act, before purchasing a chainsaw the DENR shall issue a permit to purchase to a private individual and advised to complete all the requirements needed and submit to the office for them to review and evaluate. He also explained that they shall only purchase to the authorized/registered

reseller/dealer of chainsaw. He added that in the case of LGU for emergency purposes or disaster, just inform the DENR and submit a resolution for the purpose.

MENRO Valera of Gloria informed that in the issuance of cutting permit, even the permittee has already obtain a Brgy. Certification, they are also required to seek a Municipal Certification for the information of the Mayor for their application of cutting permit.

CENRO Boyles agreed with MENRO Valera and advised her to furnish the CENRO Roxas a Municipal Ordinance regarding the issuance of cutting permit.

Another question raised by MENRO Valera is the status of devolution of DENR. CENRO Boyles answered "wala pang latest update regarding DENR devolution".

MENRO Frances Panaligan of Mansalay asked regarding the boundaries of San Rafael Caves. She mentioned that they have already sent an inquiry letter to CENRO Roxas for the boundaries which they will be used for the development of San Rafael Caves. SEMS Jose Montecalvo explained that some boundaries of San Rafael Cave falls on titled property and forest zone. He stressed that they have already executed a MOA between DENR and LGU but the private individual is not cooperating.

Mr. Jonathan F. Villas from DPWH, asked how many days before the approval on filing of CNC and ECC?

PEMU Ederlita U. Labre answered that filing of CNC and ECC for flood mitigation is manual and she advised to complete all the requirements before submitting. She promised to check and follow up the status at EMB. She also reminded that LGU shall review the tenure plan.

MENRO Valera of Gloria requested for technical and financial assistance in the delineation of mapping for the production and protection zone for the municipality of Gloria. PO II Nestor Mira answered that they shall send a letter request to DENR for financial and technical assistance.

PNP asked what is their stand in the apprehension of charcoal?manghuhuli o hindi?

Forester III Rick Dumadadag Chief MES of PENRO answered that based on the instruction from the Legal Division of the Regional Office just respect the ruling of the Judge. CENRO Boyles suggested to apprehend the charcoal without permit.

PNP requested to set an Open Forum to discuss the legal basis in the apprehension of illegal forest products.

CENRO Boyles answered that they will conduct a Multi-Sectoral Meeting to discuss the issues and concern and also the legal basis in the apprehension of forest products and conveyances.

Forester Bea Fortu announced that if ever there are environmental issues in the community/municipalities just informed immediately the DENR Office or Ms. Fortu for immediate action.

CENRO Boyles reminded the PNP that if they have encountered illegal forest products, they shall turned-over to DENR Office for proper filing of case.

After the discussion of the issues and concerns raised by the participants CENRO Quebec delivered his Closing Remarks. He thanked all the participants for attending the meeting and for their support in the implementation of DENR projects and programs.

The meeting adjourned at about 5:00 in the afternoon.




