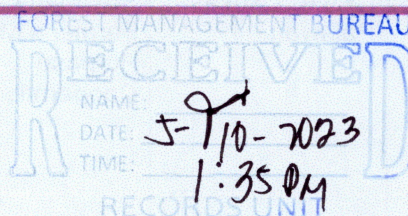

In accordance with the fax message dated 30 March 2023 of the Forest Management Bureau (FMB) regarding the upcoming sectoral consultation workshop on forestry related concerns to present and provide list of Community Based Forest Management Agreement (CBFMA) holders that are eligible for expansion based on DENR Administrative Order (DAO) No. 2021-42: Guidelines on the processing of applications for expansion of areas under CBFMA to cover adjacent untenured areas within forestlands.

Relative hereto, the list of CBFMA holders eligible for area expansion based on DAO 2021-42 is hereby respectfully submitted. Twelve CBFM holders from (1) PENRO Marinduque, (8) PENRO Palawan, and (3) PENRO Occidental Mindoro are on the list and are eligible for expansion, with a total area of 2837 hectares.

This has reference to your Memorandum dated 14 April 2023 regarding the above subject.

In line with this, hereunder are our comments on Proposed Senate Resolution No. 472 - entitled "*Resolution Directing the Senate Committee on Tourism to Examine the Creation of Policy Reforms and Budgetary Expenditures to Develop Philippines' Potential to be the Leading Country in the World for Sustainable Nature-Based Tourism (NBT)*" as proposed by Senator Sonny Angara.

1. This Office fully supports the proposed resolution to provide legislative measures in order to address policy gaps and funding requirements relative to the initiatives in developing our country's potential for sustainable nature-based tourism in collaboration with different national agencies, concerned sectors and stakeholders.
2. On the 1st whereas regarding the Tourism Act of 2009, revise Republic Act No. 9656 to Republic Act No. 9593.
3. Clarify the scope of the proposed resolution whether or not it covers only the Verde Island Passage as specified in the 8th whereas.
4. Clarification on the term "*sustainable nature-based tourism*" and "*ecotourism*" for harmonized terminologies. Under Section 4 of DENR Department Administrative Order No. 2013-19, *Ecotourism refers to a form of sustainable tourism within a natural and cultural heritage area where community participation, protection and management of natural resources, culture and indigenous knowledge and practices, environmental education and ethics as well as economic benefits are fostered and pursued for the enrichment of host communities and satisfaction of visitors.*
5. Consistent with Section 33 of RA 9593, specifying the role of DENR in identification of areas covered by the NIPAS with ecotourism potentials and cultural heritage value, and prepare policies, plans and programs for their development, preservation, operation or conversion into Tourism Enterprise Zones (TEZ), all DENR existing policies, rules and regulations relative to environmental protection and biodiversity conservation shall apply; such as those areas covered by the

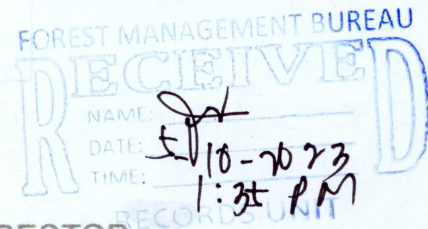

This pertains to the Memorandum dated January 23, 2023 of PENRO Oriental Mindoro forwarding the application for area expansion of Gratuitous Special Use Permit (GSUP) of the Municipal Local Government Unit (MLGU) of Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro.

Considering the merit of the request, PENRO/CENRO recommendations, compliance to documentary requirements of the applicant and pursuant to the DENR Administrative Order No. 2022-01 regarding "Guidelines in Granting Government Agencies Gratuitous Permits for the Special Uses of Forest Lands", **Gratuitous Special Use Permit No. DENR-MIMAROPA-GSUP-2022-04** is hereby **AMENDED** in favor of the Municipal Local Government Unit (MLGU) of Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro for the special use of some portion of forest lands on the concreting of Farm-to-Market Road (FMR) and construction of bridge that will cover the development of the 4.12 hectares (approximately 2,061 meters long and 20 meters wide) to be funded by the Department of Agriculture-Philippine Rural Development Project (DA-PRDP) at Sitio Centro-Panluan-Balete, Barangay Hagan, Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro.

In this regard, your Office is hereby instructed to facilitate the following, to wit:

1. Conduct survey and mapping to look for an appropriate replacement area that is equivalent to the National Greening Program (NGP) area that will be affected by the road concreting activities of the LGU;
2. Determine the appropriate species to be planted in the replacement area;
3. Supervise the seedling production, plantation establishment, and maintenance and protection activities in the replacement area;

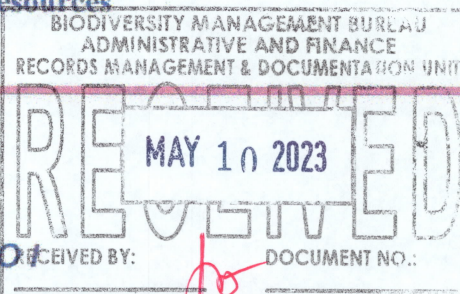

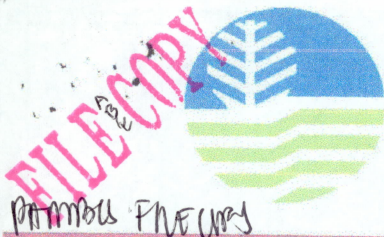

Respectfully submitted is the Memorandum dated January 13, 2023 of PENRO Palawan regarding the submission of the Annual Accomplishment Report of Malampaya Sound Protected Landscape and Seascape (MSPLS), Taytay-San Vicente, Palawan for CY 2022 pursuant to Section 27 of the NIPAS Act, as amended.

Please be informed that the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) of MSPLS had accomplished its targets in accordance with the approved Work and Financial Plan for CY 2022 through the collaborative effort and commitment of the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) Staff together with the untiring support of our partners in conservation and stakeholders.

Related continuing capacity building among the PAMO Staff were likewise implemented with the conduct of two (2) orientation activities on coastal and marine ecosystem management, such were, 1) *seagrass assessment and monitoring protocol* and 2) *mangrove and coral assessment and monitoring*.

Equally important is the inclusion of report on the Protected Area Suitability Assessment (PASA) of MSPLS wherein it was recommended by the PAMO that the modification of the PA boundary be considered pursuant to RA 7586, as amended and likewise the results of public consultation and hearing with the local community and stakeholder, on-site observation and Spatial Analysis workshop.

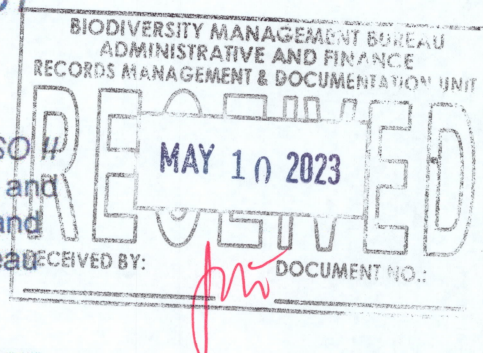

Respectfully submitted is the Memorandum dated January 30, 2023 of PENRO Palawan regarding the submission of the Annual Accomplishment Report of El Nido-Taytay Managed Resource Protected Area (ENTMRPA) for CY 2022 pursuant to Section 27 of the ENIPAS Law.

Please be informed that the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) of ENTMRPA operated under three (3) funding sources, such were the: 1) regular fund allocation from the annual General Appropriations Act for CY 2022 through the approved Work and Financial Plan for CY 2022, 2) IPAF Work and Financial Plan CY 2022 and 3) the Ecotourism Development Fund (ETDF) allocation from LGU El Nido.

All targets programmed under these fund sources were accomplished through the collaborative efforts of the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) Staff and partners in the conservation and protection of the protected area.

In relation to the Protected Area Suitability Assessment (PASA) of ENTMRPA which is aimed for the modification of boundary (establishment or disestablishment), the public consultation conducted in 18 barangays covered by the PA was completed while the following activities are still in progress/on-going as of December 2022:

- 1) Collection of Secondary data in coordination with stakeholders
- 2) Conduct of On-site observation (posted through PBAC/PhilGEPS and awaiting for the approval of the contract of service)
