Based on the said report, the holder is inactive in terms of receiving CBFMA related projects, however, they are active as cooperative providing lending services to its members and have rental space as their income. Also, they believed that their CBFMA had long been terminated resulting to unprotected area allowing illegal settlers to occupy inside the granted area.

Moreover, it is highly recommended to grant them livelihood programs as well as to re-organize their association since most of their Officials are now senior citizen, thus, allowing more active younger member to lead the CBFMA-PO in its environmental endeavor hence, reorientation program is a must to strengthen and revive the said people's organization.

Please be informed that on March 17, 2023 the undersigned team together with Forest Protection Officer Jess Mark Fallarcuna and MEO Nympha Tabinga conducted Compliance Monitoring San Jose Multi-Purpose Association Association in Barangay San Jose, Roxas, Palawan.

The following are the findings and recommendations of the team

- 1. Based on our records, the holder is inactive however during our monitoring, the cooperative is inactive in terms of CBFMA, but still active as cooperative. They actually have a rental space and provides lending services. The officials and members are also active.
- 2. Believing that their CBFM Agreement has long been terminated, relieving them from the responsibility of protecting the CBFMA area, the members ceased to protect it. As a result, there are areas now occupied by illegal settlers.
- 3. The fact that their association remained active without livelihood programs from our department, means that they are well-managed. Thus, we highly recommends provision of livelihood program. Also, they actually wanted to reorganize if just in case given the assistance since most of the officials are now senior citizens, they prefer the younger generation to lead the organization.
