Respectfully submitted is the report on the conducted scubasurero and coastal cleanup at Snake Island – NCMCR, Honda Bay, Barangay Manalo, Puerto Princesa City on April 21, 2023.

Please be informed that this office received a letter from the PNP Maritime requesting to conduct the scubasurero and coastal clean-up activity at Snake Island-National Coastal and Marine Center for Research on April 21, 2023, as part of their initiative in addressing the current environmental issues and improving the condition of critical marine ecosystems.

On the day of the activity, at 6:30 a.m., the team from PNP Maritime, composed of 5 men and 11 women, conducted the coastal clean-up and scubasurero activity with assistance from the DENR PENRO-SIMO staff, represented by Research Assistant Jamael Masacal, Law Enforcement Officers Mark Angel Lito and Rugymel Monticod. The participants were divided into two (2) groups; one group was sent to the northern part of the island, while the other group was assigned to conduct the scubasurero activity. A total of seven (7) trash bags weighing 53 kilos were collected, covering a distance of 200 meters, while three (3) net bags were collected by the scubasurero team weighing 8 kilos.

Later, the participants were instructed to classify the collected marine debris using the trash data form of Snake Island to witness the types of marine debris that dominates the coastal areas. After the sorting, the type of marine debris that dominated the island was plastic bottles (473 pcs) followed by Plastic Wrappers (200 pcs), Styrofoam (178 pcs), Rubber (81pcs) and Glass Bottles (46 pcs). The collected trashes were brought back to the mainland for proper disposal.

The activity was participated by a total of twenty-five (25) individuals composed of 10 men and 15 women from DENR PENRO and PNP Maritime.







