

SUBJECT : **SUBMISSION OF 1ST SEMESTER ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT ON THE CONDUCTED ORIENTATION OF MOUNT MANTALINGAHAN PROTECTED LANDSCAPE (MMPL) HIKERS.**



Submitted is the complete documentation of the conducted orientation of the MMPL Hikers for the 1st quarter CY 2023.

Please be informed that Mount Mantalingahan Protected Landscape- Protected Area Management Office (MMPL-PAMO) staff accomplished the 1st quarter orientation of MMPL hikers.

The participants/hikers were oriented by means of Audio Visual Presentation (AVP's), the first presentation viewed the profile and biophysical of MMPL, the second presentation was the terms and condition when visiting Mount Mantalingahan Protected Landscape such as;

- 1.) to secure permits from the MMPL PAMO CENRO-Quezon office,
- 2.) access permit must be filed at least five (5) days before the actual date of visit/entry,
- 3.) all luggage and items brought by them are subject to inspection by the duly authorized representative/s,
- 4.) prohibited drugs, hard liquors and gambling are not allowed,
- 5.) no permanent/temporary structures shall be constructed during the stay in MMPL that will detract from or destroy its features,
- 6.) hunting, killing and/or wounding of wildlife, cutting of trees and gathering/collecting of wild plants and other forest products are strictly prohibited,
- 7.) building of fire for cooking/ camping purposes shall be allowed only in designated areas and should be put off properly after use,
- 8.) the permittee shall keep the area clean and sanitary at all times. Garbage and other refuse shall be disposed of properly outside of the protected area, anything brought in must be brought out and properly disposed, the used of wet wipes is now prohibited,
- 9.) the PAMB/DENR is not liable for any loss of/damage on the personal properties/belongings or injury or death due to accident that may happen to any member of the group during the duration of visit a medical certificate is required with validity of 5days before the actual visitation, an additional fee of Php 5,000 per day for commercial filming, documentary, exhibits and photography is required,
- 10.) proper acknowledgement for the use of MMPL in television, movies, websites and publications.

- 11.) violations of any of the above-mentioned terms and conditions herein stipulated will be sufficient ground for the cancellation of this permit and the permittee shall be held liable to the penalties provided for under existing rules and regulation of the DENR/PAMB.

Moreover, important additional reminders were discussed verbally by the CEPA officer such as, wet wipes is totally banned in MMPL as agreed by the PAMB members during the 20th PAMB Enbanc meeting as support to the result of the site inspection conducted by the PAMO last November 2022.

Furthermore, the office collected PHP 8,000.00 conservation fee to 32 hikers, PHP 250.00 conservation fee for the two researcher endorsed by PAMB Members and PHP 5,000.00 payment from Knowledge Channel video documentation/ filming fee. A total of PHP13, 250.00 was collected and deposited to MMPL trust fund account-LGU Quezon, since MMPL is in the process of opening its Integrated Protected Area Fund (IPAF) account.

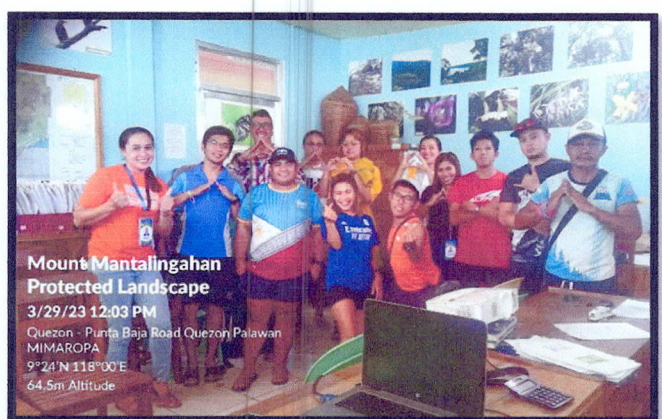

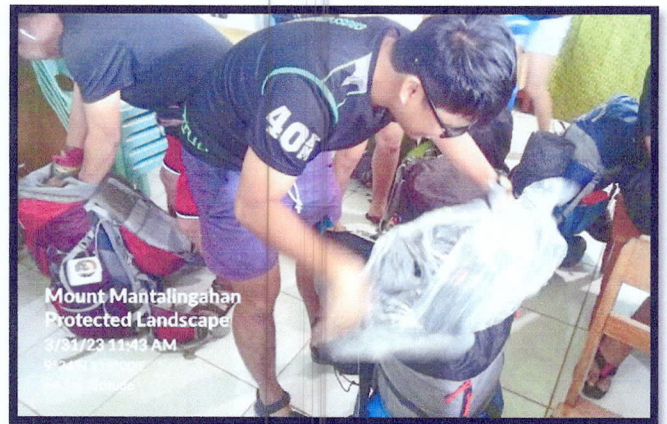

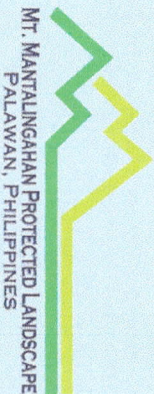
