SUBJECT : **SURVEY OF FLYING FOX ROOSTING SITE IN BARANGAY MINARA, ROXAS, PALAWAN**




Through interviews with barangay officials and fishermen of Barangay Minara, Roxas, Palawan during the previous activities done in the said barangay, it was found out that there is a roosting site of flying foxes in its mangrove area. The undersigned coordinated with the barangay officials and sent a letter for the conduct of survey of flying foxes months before the conduct of such. On April 12, 2023, the undersigned conducted a Communication, Education, and Public Awareness (CEPA) on flying foxes to the barangay officials of Barangay Minara. FT I Chuckie Y. Aguilos discussed some basic facts about flying foxes and their importance as well as Republic Act 9147. He also discussed the reason for monitoring the flying foxes. The CEPA was concluded by a turnover of CEPA materials to the barangay officials.

The team went back to the area on April 13, 2023 to conduct a flying fox flyout count after the rain had stopped. It was cloudy and other parts of the country was under storm signal number 1 due to typhoon "Amang". Barangay Tanod Alvin Nangit, a fisherman, served as our guide and boatman. He stated that he saw flying foxes roosting in the mangrove area a week prior to the activity. In addition to this, other fishermen and barangay officials stated that the roost of flying foxes has been observed in the mangrove area of Barangay Minara since 1970s. The team navigated the Minara River and waited for the flyout until the sun set but there was no flyout. It was already too dark to see so the team decided to stop and planned to go back when the weather is favourable. It was noted during the previous surveys in other areas that no flyout is observed when the weather is not favourable.

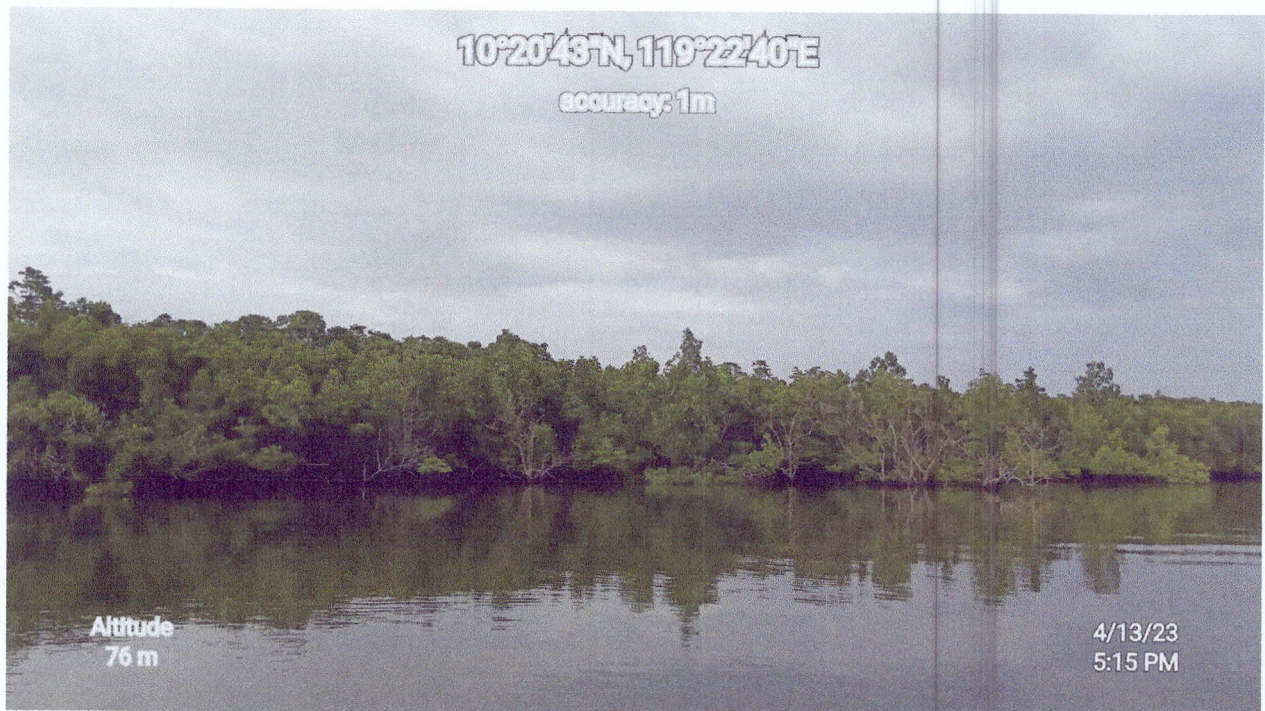

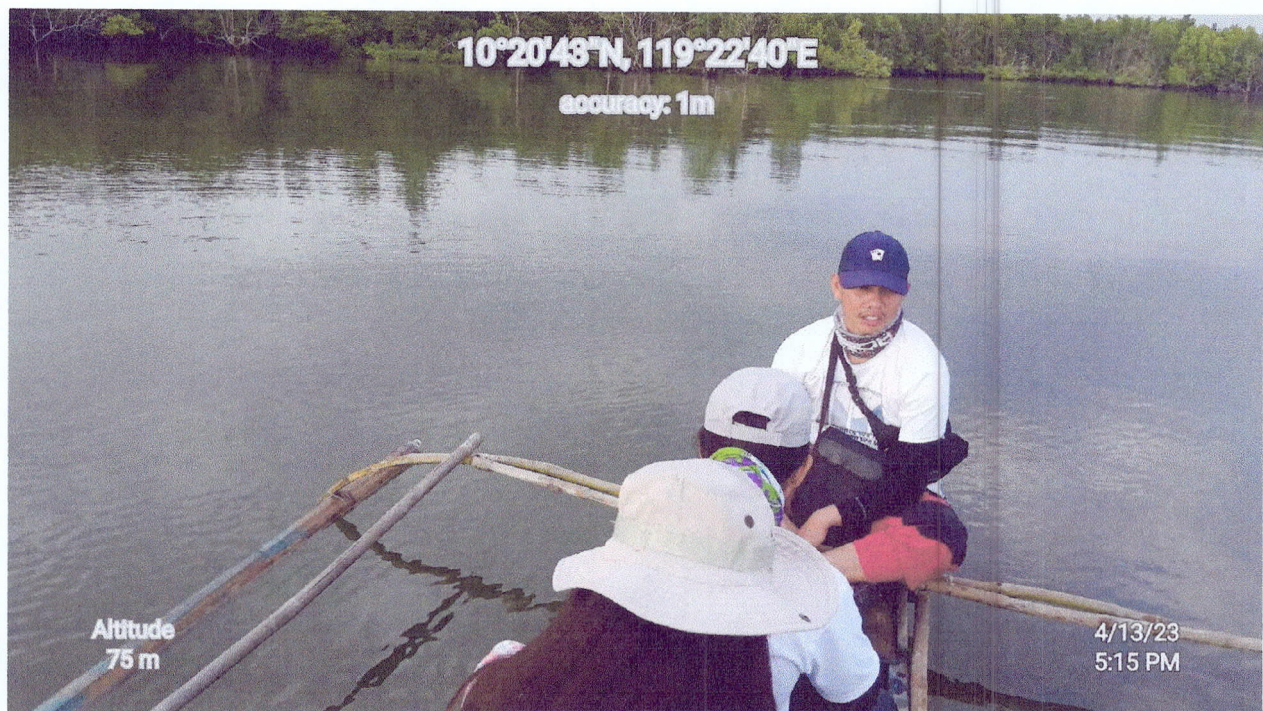




Part of Barangay Minara where flying foxes can be seen during flyout

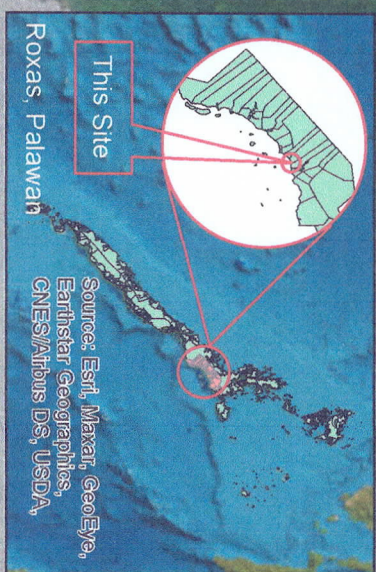
