
Please be informed that on March 22, 2023 the undersigned team together with Forest Protection Officer Jerick Ron M. Seño conducted Compliance Monitoring of SLUP No. DENR MIMAROPA 2021-005 awarded to Petrogreen Energy Corporation located in Barangay New Agutaya, San Vicente, Palawan.


The following are the finding and recommendations of the team:

1. The area is not yet operational thus Pollution Control Officer is not yet required. The holder was advised to designate a Pollution Control Officer once the site is operational;
2. The area is recommended for Performance Evaluation since it is about to expire on March 9, 2024;
3. Based on the interview with Mr. Ventura, once their SLUP expired, they will demolish the erected structures since they were only collecting wind data for possible establishment of a Wind Farm in San Vicente, Palawan. Accordingly, the gathered data indicates the possibility of the said project and they will apply for FLAg for each suitable area for construction of the Windmills once there project is approved by the Local Government of San Vicente, Palawan; and
4. Lastly, they are compliant to all conditions stipulated in the contract.
