RATIONALE:

Republic Act No. 7586 known as the "National Integrated Protected Areas System Act of 1992" as amended by Republic Act No. 11038 known as the "Expanded National Integrated Protected Areas System Act of 2018" and the DENR Administrative Order No. 2019-05 or the Implementing Rules and Regulations provide over-all policies in the protection, conservation, development and management of the protected area through functional Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) and Protected Area Management Office (PAMO).

One of the protected areas in the region is CALSANAG Watershed Forest Reserve (CWFR). It is declared under Presidential Proclamation No. 2186 dated April 29, 1982 with an area of 2,670 hectares located in the Municipalities of Calatrava, San Andres and San Agustin, Romblon. It is considered as the last frontier of biodiversity in Tablas Island, Romblon and designated as initial component under National Integrated Protected Areas System (NIPAS).

In 2017, this protected area through its Board adopted and implemented Protected Area Management Plan. This Management plan is geared towards protection of the CALSANAG Watershed Forest Reserve and one of the ten (10) identified goals is to develop training programs and activities to capacitate the key stakeholders that will improve their commitment to implement management protection policies in their respective area.

Aside from this, the Revised CWFR-PAMB Manual of Operations (2020), Capacity Building Plan per Training Needs Assessment Result (2022), and the recent Ten-Year Communication Plan (2023-2032) provide the continuous capacitation of the PAMB and PAMO staff in reference to the relevant policies like 2020-2022 DENR CEPA Medium-Term Plan; 2011-

2020 United Nations (UN) Decade on Biodiversity; the new 2021-2030 UN Decade on Ecosystem Restoration; the 2020 Year of the Protected Areas; and DENR Administrative Order 2016-12 known as "Adopting the Philippine Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan (PBSAP) 2015-2028.

Likewise, the capacity building plan per training needs assessment result of CALSANAG Watershed Forest Reserve served as the primary basis in the conduct of this experiential learning as one of the interventions that can reduce, if not eliminate, the gap, by equipping the participants with knowledge and skills and by encouraging them to build and enhance their capabilities in managing the protected area.

Experiential learning through site visit in one of the legislated protected areas in the region namely Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park in Sibuyan Island, Romblon enhances leadership skills and technical abilities of the members of CALSANAG Watershed Forest Reserve-Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) and Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) staff.

OBJECTIVES:

Generally, capacitate the prime movers of CALSANAG Watershed Forest Reserve-PAMB and PAMO through experiential learning program.

Specifically:

- 1.) To understand relevant laws, rules, regulations, issuances and other policies implemented in the protected area under NIPAS;
- 2.) To mainstream various plans and programs of DENR and LGUs for the Protected Area Management;
- 3.) To expose participants to first-hand experiences specifically on PA Management, Biodiversity Conservation, Law Enforcement, LGU/POs Linkages, Sustainable Financing & CEPA; and
- 4.) To promote cooperation and networking among the PAMB and PAMO of MGGNP and CWFR.

METHODOLOGY:

There will be Lectures, Sharing of Best Practices, Workshops, Group Dynamics/Video presentations and Field Visit activities in support to the protection, conservation, development and management of a protected area.
