Respectfully forwarded is the memorandum dated March 27, 2023 of CENRO Coron, Palawan re: the above subject.

Please be informed that updating of GEM Coron Master Plan was conducted prior to the actual site validation by the team from Regional Office and GEM Coron staff.

Hence, during validation, the team observed households in Poblacion Barangays and business stalls at public market directly discharge water waste to areas that will possibly flow to river/water ways leading to the sea. Moreover, Slaughter house of LGU Coron was observed not being compliant to the sanitary rules.

In this regard, the team recommends to conduct 100% inventory on establishments within GEM target barangays to address all issues found in the area.

This serves as **Means of Verification (MoV)** for target activities under GEM CY 2023.

This is in connection to the conducted GEM validation, evaluation and site visit on March 9, 2023 within the target barangays of Coron, Palawan.

Before the actual validation commence, the team from the Regional Office and GEM Coron staff promptly conducted the updating of the GEM Coron Master Plan.

On the following days, the team have conducted site visit and ground validation on the target barangays of GEM to determine and observe the actual situation and issues that was identified to address in the project. During validation, the Team observed some households in Poblacion barangays and business stall at public market directly discharging water waste possibly to going to river/water ways then down to the sea. Slaughter house of LGU Coron is also observed to be not compliant to the sanitary rules having no proper septic tanks discharging water waste in an adjacent area of the property causes stagnant/clogged water produces foul smell.

The validating team recommends to conduct a 100% inventory on establishments within GEM target barangays to address all the issues found in the area.























At Reclamation Area, Barangays Poblacion 2,3 and 5, Coron, Palawan


