

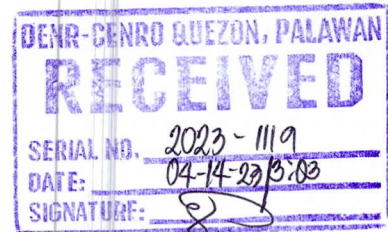

MEETING PROPER

I. PRELIMINARIES

The meeting started at exactly 2:29 in the afternoon of November 29, 2022, with an opening prayer led by Ms. Niña Liza B. Navanes, followed by the National Anthem, DENR hymn, and Narra hymn.

II. DETERMINATION OF QUORUM AND CALL TO ORDER

The secretariat read and acknowledged the thirteen (13) attending PAMB members, three (3) of whom attended face-to-face and ten (10) via Zoom. The number of attendees comprised the quorum (50+1), and hence, the presiding chair declared a quorum.

Prior to the meeting, the head secretariat suggested that nominating a Presiding Chair among the present regular members was necessary since the PAMB Chairperson was absent. Hon. Don Veneranda nominated Mr. Sherwin Corpuz of the Municipal Tourism Office of LGU-Narra as the presiding chair and was duly seconded by Hon. Mauro E. Gapuz. The board concurred with the nomination, and Mr. Corpuz presided over the meeting.

III. READING AND DISPOSITION OF PREVIOUS MINUTES OF MEETING

The secretariat presented the minutes of the 4th PAMB en banc meeting held on November 24, 2022, at Balai Emma Resort, Bgy. Antipuluan, Narra, Palawan. The Chair gave the members two (2) minutes to read the minutes, which were disseminated to them through email and displayed on the screen. Since there were no matters taken up from the previous meeting's minutes, Hon. Veneranda moved for the approval of the minutes of the 4th PAMB en banc meeting, which Hon. Gapuz duly seconded. The minutes of the previous meeting was therefore approved.

28 The meeting proceeded with the business arising from the previous minutes. However,
29 since there were no issues or business raised and discussed, the chair proceeded with the
30 approval of the agenda.

33 The secretariat presented the agenda for the special PAMB en banc meeting. The chair
34 asked the attending PAMB members to approve the presented agenda. No objections were
35 raised regarding the agenda. Hon. Veneranda moved for the approval of the agenda, which Ms.
36 Shiela Nalda duly seconded.

38 **A. PAMB RESOLUTION NO. 2022 – 04: “ A RESOLUTION TO STRICTLY**

44 The secretariat presented the resolution to the board.

46 The chair asked for their comments and suggestions. Ms. Anna Rose Agullo of KFI
47 inquired if the comments and suggestions of Ms. Indira Dayang L. Widmann were already
48 incorporated into the resolution. PASu Ma. Teresa V. Ayson explained that the draft PAMB
49 resolution 2022-04 was already presented at the previous PAMB meeting held on November
50 24, 2023, and was disseminated to the PAMB members for their comments, suggestions, and
51 insertions. She also confirmed that the suggestions of Ms. Widmann were already included
52 in the presented resolution.

53
54 The chair and the board agreed to pass the resolution and to create another resolution
55 requesting the Sangguniang Bayan of LGU-Narra to enact an ordinance identical to PAMB
56 resolution No. 2022-04 as a penalty clause. PASu Ayson added that this resolution was in
57 accordance with RA 11038 or the ENIPAS Act, which states that any person who commits
58 a violation shall be subject to a penalty pursuant to sections 20(f) and (l). The board
59 concurred to create a resolution requesting the Sangguniang Bayan, through Hon. Joseph
60 Cruzat, the chairperson of the committee of the environment, to enact an ordinance to support
61 PAMB resolution No. 2022-04.

62 **B. OTHER MATTERS**

64 There were no other matters and issues raised and discussed by the board.

VII. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further matters to be taken up, the meeting was adjourned by Ms. Nalda and duly seconded by Hon. Veneranda at around 3:06 in the afternoon.

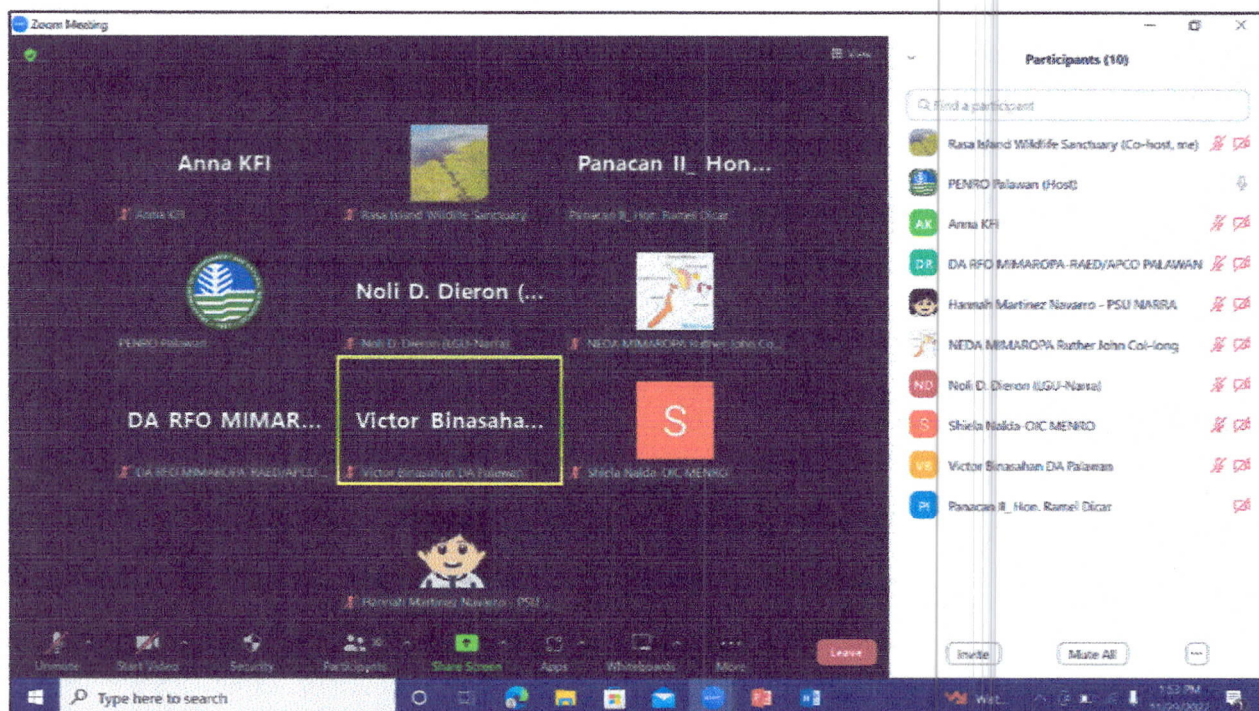

RESOLUTION NO. 004 Series of 2022

A RESOLUTION TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT, OBSERVE, AND PRACTICE PROPER SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AND DISCOURAGE THE TRANSPORTATION AND USE OF SINGLE-USE PLASTIC PRODUCTS WITHIN THE PROTECTED AREA-RASA ISLAND WILDLIFE SANCTUARY

WHEREAS, Rasa Island was declared as Wildlife Sanctuary last February 15, 2006 by virtue of Presidential Proclamation 1000 Pursuant to the Republic Act 7586 as amended by RA 11038 known as Expanded National Integrated Protected Area (ENIPAS) Act of 2018;

WHEREAS, the RIWS Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) was created as the sole-policy making body of the Rasa Island Sanctuary as mandated in Presidential Proclamation No. 1000, and pursuant to the provision of the Expanded National Integrated Protected Areas System Act of 2018;

WHEREAS, significant part of the Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary is a Marine Protected Area with rich and marine biodiversity (species and ecosystems) that conservation and protection is strictly enforced;

WHEREAS, the Republic Act 9003 known as Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 and RA 11038 ENIPAS Act of 2018 shall be strictly implemented, observed and practiced within the Protected Area;

WHEREAS, the visitors/tourists and any person(s) visiting Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary shall be strictly prohibited to dumping, littering and leave their trash in Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary and transportation and use of single-use plastic products shall likewise be discouraged;

WHEREAS, the single-use plastic products that shall be prohibited in the PA-RIWS include but are not limited to plastic bags, straws, coffee stirrers, soda and water bottles, disposable utensils, wet wipes, cigarette butts, and most food packaging that are disposable in nature but are non-biodegradable;
