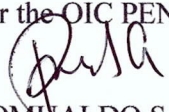

**ACTIVITY REPORT ON THE WRITESHOP FOR THE PREPARATION OF
BUNGAO CAVE MANAGEMENT PLAN**

Brgy. Iling Proper, Ilin Island, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro
April 18-19, 2023

I. Background and Rationale:

Caves are very crucial for the conservation of biodiversity. They provide habitat to some of the country's threatened animals which are yet to be protected by the existing network of protected areas. Seven caves are with protected area status representing less than one percent while **there are around 300 caves initially assessed for cave management plan preparation.**

Caves are classified based on the protection of geological, biological, cultural, and paleontological features and to provide safe recreational, educational, scientific, and other resource-based utilization opportunities.

Bungao Cave is located in Sitio Mangga, Brgy. Iling Proper, Ilin Island, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro and was classified as **Class I^C** or Caves with extremely hazardous conditions (e.g. bad air, unstable ceiling, presence of rockfall/ breakdown, etc.) **per DENR Memorandum Circular No. 2018-09 dated August 16, 2018.**

For this year, one of the major Program/Activity/Projects (PAPs) that will be undertaken by the Conservation and Development Section-Biodiversity Management Unit (CDS-BMU) under the Management of Caves and Cave Resources is the **Preparation of Cave Management Plan for Bungao** to ensure that this cave will be properly conserved and protected.

II. Objectives:

- 2.1 To present the results of the re-assessment in Bungao Cave and KII conducted among the cave stakeholders in Brgy. Iling Proper, Ilin Island, San Jose;
- 2.2 To determine the management strategies and interventions that are applicable for Bungao Cave; and
- 2.3 To formulate a Protection and Conservation Plan for Bungao Cave following the prescribed format per BMB Technical Bulletin No. 2016-10 dated December 28, 2016 RE: Outline of Cave/Wetland Management Plans.

III. Participants:

The writeshop was successfully attended and actively participated by thirty (30) individuals composed of 18 male and 12 female stakeholders. The participants were comprised of the BLGU-Iling Proper officials, BHWs and Barangay Police, LGU-San Jose's MENRO and MTCDO Cave Assessment Team members, MAO extension officers, LGU-San Jose Satellite Office representatives, Occidental Mindoro State College – Research, Development and Extension (RDE), representatives from Sitio Mangga, other concerned local residents and selected CENRO-San Jose personnel. The activity was facilitated by the CDS-Biodiversity Management Unit staffs.

IV. Date and Venue of the Activity:

The 2-day writeshop was undertaken at the LGU-San Jose Satellite Office in Barangay Iling Proper, Ilin Island on April 18-19, 2023.
