

This pertains to the target activity on the conduct of compliance monitoring on the delineated easement and inventoried affected establishments under the Enforcement of Laws and Regulations of the GEM Project under SAA No. CO-R4B-101-2021-07-514. Please be informed that the Inventory and Compliance and Monitoring Team had already conducted compliance monitoring on the establishments and households issued with NTVs in barangay Bucana, Buena Suerte, Corong-corong, Maligaya and Masagana, El Nido, Palawan. Hereunder is the summary of findings of the monitoring conducted:

Other Findings and Observation per barangay:

BUCANA

Out of the 23 commercial establishments listed with NTVs, 13 had already completed the demolition of structures that falls within the established easement zones by the 2019 Task Force namely *Valine and Grace Beach Cottages, Balay Gamay, Bamboo House, Clubruby Resto, Ems Café And Restaurant, Jaime Cu Cottages, Jams Massage and Spa, Kaila's Resto/Cusina, Mad Monkey, Nacpan Beach Resort and Massage, Seaside, Sunmai, and North Swell El Nido Surfing. Faith In Christ Jesus Church* was found to be abandoned during the monitoring but still not vacated the easement area. The church believers, accordingly, had transferred to the lot owned by certain Mr. Mariano. Two (2) establishments had changed their name: *Paradise Inn* now named as *Calitang Pearl Cottages* and *Tommy Marine Products* now *168 Fishing Enterprise*.

Further, only 357 out of the 359 households in the master list were monitored. Out of which, two (2) were found to be compliant, 10 were not found during the monitoring period, three (3) were found to be seasonal renters and transferred to other areas and/or barangays, six (6) were abandoned but not still vacated the easement area, two (2) were occupied by new owners/tenants, and three (3) were living with other households and abandoned the properties. Additionally, Mr. Joet Albag was alleged to have the same identity with Mr. Joey Albag and Mr. Rogelio Magallanes is same person as Mr. Rogerto Magallanes. There were also three (3) households who had submitted response to the issued NTVs to the barangay but they got no response up to this moment.

BUENA SUERTE

For Bgy. Buena Suerte, 30 commercial establishments listed with NTVs in Bgy. Buena Suerte were found but one was actually within the jurisdiction of Bgy. Bebeladan (Ten Knots Development Corporation in Entalula Beach). Some declared closure due to pandemic while some are temporarily closed. Out of the 30 commercial establishments, five (5) has an on-going application for Special Use Agreement in Protected Areas (SAPA) namely Cauayan Island Resort in Cauayan Island, Dilumacad Island Residential Beach House in Helicopter Island, Green Turtle Resort and properties of Mr. Jorge Dela Torre and Mr. Noel Cariño all in Seven Commandos beach. Establishments that were found to be occupying one building previously were La Salangane and Isla Expeditions, which are now CLOSED and demolished the portion affected by the easement zones, and Café Athena and Organic Spa owned by Greek Taverna Incorporation. New structure is being built within the area previously occupied by La Salangane and Isla Expeditions and new ownership, under the name of Mr. Philip Morales, took over the property previously occupied by Shorepass lodge.

On the level of compliance, there are 21 establishments complied on the issued NTV within easement, nine (9) were found to be non-compliant. On the other hand, out of the 12 establishments built within timberland areas, only the property of Mr. Jorge Dela Torre in Seven Commandos Beach was found to be compliant to the issued NTV within timberland areas since the area has no structures built within while 11 establishments were found to be non-compliant. Moreover, majority of establishments that were identified to be non-compliant to the issued NTV within timberland areas manifested '**no violation**' because they are allegedly title holders.

Further, six (6) out of the 141 households in the master list were not found during the monitoring period. Out of the 135 monitored, three (3) were found to have initiated self-demolition namely Dinsay, Julito; Pinto, Christopher and Repana, Teting but he still fenced the said empty lot. Out of the 6 households that were not found, there were four (4) renting houses in the barangay and had also left during the onset of pandemic. Additionally, Mr. Albano, Edwin was alleged to have the same identity with Mr. Anabo, Edwin. There are 31 individuals and household that within the NSMNP who have actually and continuously occupied such areas for five (5) years prior to March 10, 1997. In addition, There were 16 individuals issued with NTV's which identified that there were living in one (1) house, which is just consider as just eight (8) households in total. On the other hand, there were three (3) households that was identified as renter namely Atubang, Sindo- renter of Dreco, Rogilio, Mahinay, Gideon- renter of Boy Aya and Mahinay, Jingle- renter of Pilapil, Lito. In addition, there were 15 households need to do spelling fixing on their name just to be located. Those are Arabo, Pablo (Anabo, Pablo Jr.)/ Bohol, Livian (Bohol, Louisa)/ Hinn, Dexter (Genon, Dexter)/ Hinn, Jessa (Genon, Jessa)/ Hinn, Merlito (Genon, Merlito)/Labaho (Labajo), Windel (Wendel)/ Lauren, Lodita (Laudan, Rodito)/ Macasipong, Maximo (Macasipong, Mariano)/ Orpen, Elcid (Corpin, Eluid)/ Pilapil, Lolito (Pilapil, Rolito)/ Repancho, Bebito (Repana, Bebito)/ Rio, Reiche (Dreo, Ressurecion)/ Rio, Roly Boy (Drio, Rolly)/ Robles, Rafu (Robles, Ralph) and Sabino (Rabino).

Also, majority of the households issued with NTVs are not bonafide residents of Bgy. Buena Suerte. Some are leasing for a rent-to-own property and during the onset of the pandemic, these NTV recipients had already vacated the area.

CORONG-CORONG

Based on the monitoring conducted, only 82 out of 85 commercial establishments listed with NTVs in Bgy. Corong-corong were found but one was actually within the jurisdiction of Bgy. Maligaya (El Nido View Deck Cottages). Out of which, 19 are still operating while 63 are closed. Some declared closure due to pandemic while some are temporarily closed. 39 establishments were found to be compliant on the issued NTV within easement, six (6) were found to be non-compliant. On the other hand, only the Narayanee Corporation is found to be compliant to the issued NTV within timberland areas. The said corporation is a holder of a Memorandum of Agreement with the Department awarded in 2017. They also have an on-going application for Special Use Agreement in Protected Areas (SAPA) in the Protected Area Management Office of ENTMRPA to convert their MOA into SAPA. Moreover, 81 establishments were identified to be non-compliant to the issued NTV within timberland areas and majority of these non-compliant establishments manifested 'no violation' because they are title holders, accordingly.

On the other hand, only 118 out of the 154 households in the master list were monitored during the monitoring period. Out of these, 32 were found to have initiated self-demolition. Twenty four (24) establishments, previously living on stilt houses at Sitio Takasan, received financial assistance from the LGU and to comply with their commitments, they had initiated self-demolition and relocated somewhere else. Out of the 83 non-compliant establishments, one (1) had complied with the 3-meter easement (Mr. Eddie Brock); two (2) had double entries (Vincent Gallardo & Vicente Gallardo being the same person); a couple living in one house but were issued with separate NTVs (John Reymond and Bedy Badajos); at least 17 are just renting/leasing; one (1) was already deceased (Alexander Castro) but his house is still inhabited; two (2) had already abandoned the area but the structures remain (Jose Areas and Dennis Contreras); Mr. Israel Gomez who was listed in the households in Corong-corong with issued NTV is actually a resident of Sitio Manlalic in Bgy. Manlag although he has two establishments in Bgy. Corong-corong where one has pending SAPA application (Villa Israel Ecopark); and, at least 10 households have respective titles in their occupied lots. It was also disclosed during the monitoring that Mr. Israel D. Gomez had relocated the communities residing on his allegedly claimed lot in Sitio Dagal Dagal to the mangrove areas in Sitio Kawa-kawa of the same barangay. Accordingly, Mr. Gomez wants to sell his claimed property in Sitio Dagal-dagal.

Also, majority of the households issued with NTVs are not bonafide residents of Bgy. Corong-corong. Some are leasing for a rent-to-own property and during the onset of the pandemic, these NTV recipients had already vacated the area.

MALIGAYA

Out of four (4) commercial establishments, only El Nido Via Ferrata (Canopy Walk) and Perez boarding house are operational during the monitoring period but of limited capacity. El Nido View Deck which was listed in Bgy. Corong-corong per masterlist from the Regional Office was also added. Three establishments have titled properties while El Nido Via Ferrata has existing Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the DENR in lieu of Special Use Agreement in Protected Area (SAPA) which was still suspended back then. No structure of the above establishments had conducted demolition.

Moreover, three of the commercial establishments listed had already submitted an appeal for consideration of their issued NTVs weeks after they received the said Notice but to date, they have not yet receive a response yet. Spin Designer Hotel also said that they had filed an appeal to the Office for their issued NTVs for their alleged violation on the Presidential Decree 1067 or the Water Code of the Philippines. The proponent presented documents such as proof of ownership and other related documents of the property. Accordingly, they have no violation on the legal easement because the area at the back of the property being flooded during raining season is due to the absence of proper drainage and the fire wall built adjacent to their property.

On the other hand, most of the house owners listed in the barangay were not found during the time of the monitoring and none had complied to NTV issued. Hereunder are the other findings during the compliance monitoring of households issued with NTVs in the said barangay:

1. Mr. Harold Carbonell (listed as Aarol and Carbonell in the masterlist from the Regional Office) who previously lives at the Iglesia Ni Cristo (INC) compound had already moved to Puerto Princesa City.
2. Ms. Novie Aquino was transferred to those listed in Bgy. Corong-corong where she is a resident of and also operates Novie's Inn. Accordingly, she does not own a house in Bgy. Maligaya and was also listed in Bgy. Masagana as "Norie Aquino".
3. Mrs. Rossana Gallardo resides in their establishment (Rossana's Pension) in Bgy. Masagana who was also issued with NTV for encroaching the 3-meter easement previously marked by El Nido-Task Force Challenge but had already complied.
4. Mr. Lyndel Sabenacio had already abandoned his residence in Bgy. Maligaya and moved to Bgy. Manlag but the house/structure remains in the area.
5. Added Mr. Raymond Osorio, Gilbert Caabay, Mr. Ruben Cabral, Ms. Joy Piramide, Mr. Donald Olson, Mr. Louie Carollia, Ms. Beverly Gamia and Mr. Vito Gacot who were listed in Bgy. Masagana but actually lives in Bgy. Maligaya. Mr. Osorio has a printing business while Mr. Cabral and Ms. Piramide operate rooms-for-rent.
6. The structure of Mr. Eduardo Trinidad in the timberland area in Bgy. Maligaya in the upper portion of Balinsasayaw Road is already abandoned and the path leading to the site was inaccessible during the visit so no recent photo was taken. The team cannot reach Mr. Eduardo Trinidad to get more information during the time of monitoring.

The mangrove areas at the back of Iglesia Ni Cristo (INC) church is now encroached by certain Mr. Edgardo Sabenacio. The team also observed that a portion of the mangrove areas at the back of the INC church was converted into a pond and accordingly, the small caves under the limestone cliff (*Taraw*) are being used for baptism and other religious activities. There were also at least six (6) rest houses constructed for the purpose and the whole area is fenced by buho (bamboo) with "No Trespassing" signage installed. The team was hesitant to continue the interviews and inspection because the occupants were hostile. The above observations are violations of the Section 20 of the Presidential Decree 705 and Article 51 of Presidential Decree 1067 hence recommend to conduct further investigation on the area and issue a Notice of Violation and/or Order to Vacate if warranted.

Further, some data needed in the matrix were not captured because the monitoring was conducted on September 2021 and the official Inventory/Compliance Monitoring Form was just furnished on the last week of November 2021.

MASAGANA

Only the Kalinga Beach Resort and La Salangane were not fully compliant on the 3-meter easement previously established by Task Force El Nido Challenge. The latter have kept portion of the concrete water barrier to prevent (coconut) trees from falling. Eight (8) out of 15 commercial establishments issued with NTVs are still operational namely Caalan Beach Resort, Cadlao Resort, Cadlao Resort (Extension), Chyslik Cottages, El Nido Beach Hotel, El Nido Reef Strand Restaurant and Bar, Hadebe Beach Cottages and Rosanna's Pensionne while seven (7) are closed during the monitoring period. On the other hand, out of the 20 households, 11 were deleted - nine (9) were transferred to the list under Bgy. Maligaya being actually living in that barangay, one (1) is a resident of Bgy. Corong-corong (Mrs. Novie Aquino) and one (1) had double entry (Mr. Ardoña). Out of the remaining nine (9) on the list, two (2) were not found by the team during the monitoring period (Jayson Vargas & Rolando Liwanag), Ms. April Hortaleza was only renting in a boarding house thereat and had already moved out while Mr. Antonio and Mrs. Rita Bello are actually a couple and living in the same house. None of the households monitored had complied with the NTVs issued. It was also noted there are some establishments initiated demolition of the portions of their property near the beach although they did not receive any NTV from the Office. Further, some data needed in the matrix were not captured because the monitoring was conducted on September 2021 and the official Inventory/Compliance Monitoring Form was just furnished on the last week of November 2021.

In view of the foregoing, the following recommendations were drawn:

1. Specific clarification should be laid down on the legal easement to be imposed within the four (4) urban barangays whether it is 40m instead of 3m easement as established by El Nido Task Force considering that the previous NTVs issued to them does not expressly provided as to the distant of legal easement to be complied with.
2. Re-delineation and re-demarcation of 40meter easement should be done after the Protected Area Suitability Assessment (PASA) particularly in urban barangays considering that it is still a protected area;
3. A legal opinion should be provided for those patented area within timberland, easement zones and protected area.
4. Since most of the violations are PD 1067, the National Water Resource Board should be copy furnished of this report for information and appropriate actions

Attached are the list of non-compliant establishments and households per barangay. Please note that the comprehensive reports per barangay were already submitted before the end of 2022.
