INDICATIVE MANAGEMENT PLAN

I. INTRODUCTION

Description of the area

The Proposed project is located in Barangay Burirao and Barangay Tacras, Narra, Palawan. The beginning of the project is located in Brgy. Burirao having coordinates of 9°10′17″N, 118°08′16″E going to Barangay Tacras with the End of the project having coordinates of 9°13′32″N, 118°08′47″E. The project area is partly residential, agricultural and timberland. The alignment has an existing trail with estimated length of 4.475 kilometers that can be accessed by 4-wheeled vehicles while the other 4.0 kilometers can be accessed either motorcycle, carabo or by foot.

II. OBJECTIVES

The proposed road will serve as an access road to the production areas in the affected barangays of the municipalities of Narra and Quezon. It will also shorten the travel time and increase the national road network of Palawan. Significantly, this road can be used as an alternate route of commuters and road users from the south-east coastal areas of the province going to western municipalities and vice versa.

The proposed Burirao – Isugod Cross Country Road aims to provide better access in the transport of goods and services, accelerate socio-economic activities and condition of the communities, and lessen travel time. The project will contribute to the growth of the economy and at the same time will also improve the quality of the road condition in the area. The project covers Barangay Burirao and Tacras of the Municipality of Narra.

The completion of project road will trigger agricultural development in the influence area, as farmers will be encouraged to produce more — given the improved access to markets and to the government services. It will also enhance tourism activities on the subject municipalities as there will be ease of access to the beautiful beaches and various tourist spots located within the province of Palawan.

Target Start of Operation : July 2025

IV. TECHNICAL ASPECTS

Technical Description

The proposed project is construction of gravel road with a Width of 15.0 meters having a total length of 8.475 kilometers. The description of works to be done are: Facilities for Engineer, Earthworks, Subbase and Base Course, Drainage and Slope Protection Works, Installation of Safety Devices (Metal Guard Rail) and Tree Furnishing and Transplanting.

Description of Activities

1. Pre-Construction Phase

Activities to be undertaken in this stage cover all necessary detailed engineering plans, as follows: survey, soil investigation and materials investigation, preparation of design and project plans, preparation of specifications, quantity and cost estimates, program of works, proposed construction schedule and estimated cash flow, site or right-of-way plans including schedule of acquisition, relocation plan and submission of design report along with the preparation of Initial Environmental Examination (IEE) Checklist report and bid/tender documents.

As a standard requirement of the DPWH, the road plan is an output of majority (if not all) of the above listed activities. Safety and quality of the structure and the project as a whole is the concern of the department, such that to determine the stability of the soil foundation is imperative prior to any design and plan preparation of any project.

The DPWH Standard Specifications for Highways and Bridges provides for all precautionary measures regarding quality, economy and safety of any project of the department including environmental protection.

After all necessary activities, the project will undergo the usual standard bidding procedures for government projects.

The notice to commence work shall be issued to the winning contractor, upon approval of the contract.

2. Construction Phase

Immediately after the issuance of the Notice to Proceed to the contractor, a meeting between the proponent and the contractor will be held to discuss every responsibility in the contract.

The initial activities are to mobilize the required equipment, personnel and necessary materials to start the project at the job site. Construction of temporary facilities including campsite, bunkhouse, warehouse and stockroom will follow.

The clearing and grubbing activities including the removal of various obstructions will follow. The filling and compacting aggregate soil materials, preparation of base to the

desired grade line and compaction requirements should be in accordance with the standard specifications.

Then proceed to concrete pouring of the Portland Cement Concrete Pavement (PCCP). The next activity is the construction of slope protection, construction of drainage structures can also be undertaken depending on the prevailing weather condition in the locality. After the curing stage of all concreting works, remove the forms and supports. All reusable materials will be deposited at the contractor's stockpile. All combustible items and waste materials will be disposed and deposited to the dumping area designated by the local officials.

3. Operational Phase

The Proponent shall accept the project from the Contractor after final inspection of the completed project and all the environmental requirements have been satisfied.


Vehicular traffic flow is expected to return to normal. With increased traffic capacity, inter-municipal commerce will further perk up due to accessibility to previously distant municipalities. The project will greatly enhanced the commerce between the nearby municipalities of the province as well as improved the movement of goods and services.

The operation and maintenance activities include vegetation control, clearing of side ditches, replacement/repair of traffic signs and repair of other damage structures. The work force requirements for construction will be composed of professionals, skilled, semi-skilled and labor workers. Priority for employment will be applicants from the local residents. In cases an expertise is required, hiring for such may be from other places. The following is a table showing the estimated number of persons that will involve in the implementation/construction phase.

4. Abandonment Phase

In this phase, the contract between the DPWH and Contractor is presumably finished and completed. The Contractor is responsible in clearing all temporary structures, equipment and materials within the construction area. The Contractor's Bank Houses and other usable materials may be donated to the concerned Local Government Unit with jurisdiction in the area. All operation for clearing and maintaining the cleanliness in the area including the dumping of unused materials is the contractor's responsibility.

- 4. Secure necessary cutting permits and chainsaw registration from concerned agency/ies if vegetation clearing will be undertaken;
- 5. The proponent shall submit to the PCSD a copy of the inventory of trees affected by the project;
- 6. The proponent shall provide slope protection measures to minimize siltation of earth materials;
- 7. Any adverse environmental impact caused by the implementation of the project and any nuisance to public health and safety, as may be determined by appropriate authorities, shall be sufficient grounds for the cancellation or suspension of this SEP Clearance and imposition of prescribed penalties and charges, in addition to the institution of environmental remediation actions that may be required;



This pertains to the letter request of Engineer Richard M. Crisologo, Project Engineer of Department of Public Works and Highways seeking a **Land Status Verification** to the lot affected by Regional Project with ID No. 22E00125- Access Roads and/or Bridges from the National Roads Leading to Major Strategic Public Buildings/Facilities-Construction of Buriraro-Isugod Cross Country Road, Brgy. Burirao, Narra and Brgy. Isugod, Quezon (Vis Brgy. Kalatagbak and Brgy. Maasin, Quezon). Said Land Status Verification/Certification is one of the requirements for the issuance of Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC).

Please be informed that the undersigned together with representatives of DENR CENRO Narra Station and DPWH. Based on the GIS projection and verification/inspection conducted by the undersigned, findings are as follows, to wit:

- That the road project has an approximate length of eight (8) kilometers. (Please see attached Sketch Map).
- More or less one (1) kilometer of the project appears to be within Alienable and Disposable (A&D) as per Project No. 12-E, Block No. III, LC Map No. 1952 certified December 27, 1955. Approximately five (5) cadastral lots (lot 7204, 7198, 7203, 7199, 7265) will be affected.
- That based on GIS projection, approximately, seven (7) kilometres also of the aforementioned road project is classified within Forestland/Timberland as per Project No.10-E, Block-B, LC Map No. 1952 certified December 27, 1955

- That approximately four (4) kilometers of the project area is already existing road with an average of 6 meters width and accessible by four wheel vehicles, while approximately four (4) kilometers trail is accessible only by carabao pulled sled and motorcycles.
- That said road/trail is presently used as farm to market road in the locality.
- That the road project is also adjacent to some of the National Greening Program (NGP) C.Y. 2012 but will not be affected by the construction of road.
