





C. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION

- The area, prior to the issuance of SIFMA, was previously under the Palawan Electric Company (PALECO) DENDRO Tree Plantation Project;
- That during its implementation, the occupants were convinced to join the project and were provided financial assistance to plant Ipil-Ipil trees;
- When PALECO encountered a problem securing a cutting permit for the Ipil-ipil, they were assisted to apply for individual SIFMA;
- As a result, on July 14, 1998, SIFMA No. 003-98 was issued to Honorato Mariano covering five (5) hectares;
- A certain Flaviano Sindac, Sr. facilitated the application and approval of the SIFMAs issued to 1. Flaviano Sindac, Jr., 2. Honorato Mariano, 3. Dominador Gabotero, and 4. Pernito Baude;
- After the SIFMA's approval and the cutting permit for the planted Ipil-ipil trees was secured, harvesting of the planted trees took place;
- That because the proceeds from the harvested trees went to the payment of loans to PALECO/NEA, the project was no longer continued. No new plantation was established after the harvest;
- Presently, the holder is not residing at Brgy. Barake, Aborlan, Palawan, and cannot be contacted;
- There are actual claimants in the area that have already introduced some improvements such as planting agricultural crops like coconut, and fruit-bearing trees, nipa hut and backyard livestock which serves as their source of food and livelihood; and
- Records show that there is no submission of the Annual Report and payment of rentals;
- Non-renewal of the SIFM Agreement;
- To encourage the current occupants to apply for a tenurial instrument based on their actual use; and
- CENRO PPC to recommend other appropriate tenurial instrument suited for the present land use of the area as farmland. (There should be an application first before the Office can conduct a preliminary assessment and recommend a suitable tenure instrument. In addition to it, types of tenure instruments usually based on the proposed project of the proponent or applicant)
