
During the meeting, the following inputs were noted to be considered in the Communication plan:

Please be informed that this activity was presented during the 1st Regular NLNP-Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) Meeting held on February 27, 2023 at the Pula Watershed Building, CENRO Socorro, Pasi II, Socorro, Oriental Mindoro, as well as the target on the inventory of titled lands within the protected area and the utilization of IPAF funds.

Accordingly, awareness campaigns highlighting the salient features of NLNP and Republic Act No. 11038 or Expanded National Integrated Protected Areas System (E-NIPAS) Act (amended RA 7586 should be intensified not only for the communities present within NLNP but also for all National Government Agencies (NGAs), Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), academes, etc. This shall be done to ensure that all proposed developments within the protected area will be presented first to the Board prior to the construction/implementation phase.


