This has reference to the Memorandum dated March 20, 2023 of the Director, Biodiversity Management Bureau (BMB) in concurrent capacity as Assistant Secretary for Planning, Policy and Foreign-Assisted and Special Projects.

Pursuant to DENR Administrative Order 2023-01 entitled "Mandatory Resource Persons in the Environmental Impact Assessment Review Committee (EIARC)", a representative from the Biodiversity Management Bureau (BMB) will act as Resource Speaker during the evaluation of Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and other documents related thereto by the Environmental Impact Assessment Review Committee (EIARC).

However, in cases where the BMB representative cannot participate in the evaluation, the Regional Office through the Conservation and Development Division (CDD) and/or PENRO/CENRO shall represent BMB in the said activity. In this regard, you are hereby instructed to identify and designate two (2) personnel as possible resource speaker for EIARC, who has a clear understanding of the likely impacts of a project on the environment especially on Environmentally Critical Areas (ECA) such as PA at various stages of project development.
