SUBJECT : **SUBMISSION OF ACTIVITY REPORT ON THE CONDUCTED MULTI-STAKEHOLDER REGIONAL COMMUNITY-BASED FOREST MANAGEMENT (CBFM) ACTION AND COMMUNICATION PLANNING WORKSHOP IN SUPPORT OF THE UPDATED CBFM STRATEGIC PLAN FOR CY 2023-2032 HELD AT SELAH PODS HOTEL MANILA, PASAY, METRO MANILA ON AUGUST 28-31, 2023**

This pertains to the conducted **Regional Multi-Stakeholder Community-Based Forest Management (CBFM) Action and Communication Planning Workshop in Support of the Updated CBFM Strategic Plan for CY 2023-2032** last August 28-31, 2023 at Selah Pods Hotel Manila, Pasay, Metro Manila, attended by the DENR MIMAROPA regional staff, Provincial CBFM Coordinators, CENRO CBFM Desk Officers and Focal and CBFM-POs. This is a target under the CARP FY 2023 Physical and Financial Plan, specifically under *Rationalize and Ensure Climate Resilience of ARBs Physical, Social, Environmental and Economic Support*.

On the first day of the workshop, August 29, CBFM regional updates and background information on the new CBFM Strategic Plan were presented by the DENR MIMAROPA Regional Office, MIMAROPA CBFM-PO Federation, Forest Management Bureau (FMB) and Yakap Kalikasan Tungo sa Kaunlaran ng Pilipinas (Assisting Professional of FMB). The initial part of the workshop was also conducted through identification of detailed objectives for each strategy. On the following day, August 30, the action planning workshop was conducted through the formulation of the physical and financial plan for 2023-2032 for each strategy. On the last day, August 31, a brief summary of the Forestry Investment Portal (FIP) was presented by the FMB. After, the regional communication planning workshop was conducted. Each planning workshop ended with a plenary to polish and enhance the plans.

Per agreements, the Regional Action and Communication Plan will be consolidated by the Yakap Kalikasan Tungo sa Kaunlaran ng Pilipinas, and will be presented to the region for further deliberation and finalization. In relation to this, the participating DENR Field Offices were given a deadline on the submission of the data needed to ensure that the plans to be crafted will be effective and data-driven.

Overall, a total of forty-three (43) participants attended, of which 10 were CBFM-PO members (6 females and 4 males) and 33 were personnel from the DENR, support group, and assisting professional (23 females and 10 males).

Proclaimed and Legislated PAs: 4. PA Habitat Protection; A. Implementation of Biodiversity Monitoring System (BMS) within Mt. Guiting – Guiting Natural Park (MGGNP) in Sibuyan, Romblon.

BMS was conducted using four (4) main methods: Focus Group Discussion (FGD), Field Diary, Photo Documentation and Transect Walk.

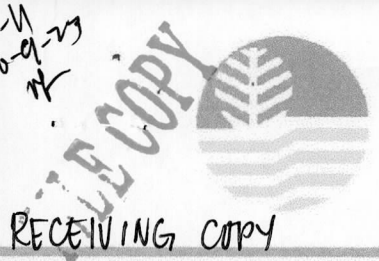
1. Focus Group Discussion (FGD)

FGD was conducted on March 31 to April 02, 2023 within the municipalities of San Fernando and Cajidiocan. The members of the Community Monitoring Group (CMG) from Barangays Panangcalan and Agtiwa in San Fernando and Barangay Lumbang Weste in Cajidiocan actively participated in providing information on the trends of biodiversity and resource uses within the protected area.

Respectfully submitted are copies of the approved minutes of meetings and resolutions of Apo Reef Natural Park (ARNP) Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) held on June 13, 2023 per Memorandum dated June 21, 2023 of the OIC PENRO Occidental Mindoro. This is part of the accomplishment for the CY 2023 target activity under OO1: Natural Resources Conservation and Development Program: Protected Area Management and Development Sub-program: II. For Proclaimed and Legislated PAs: 5. PAMB Operationalization; b: PAMB Meetings of Apo Reef Natural Park in Occidental Mindoro.

The *regular meeting* was attended by seven (8) out of nine (9) PAMB members/representative(s) through a combination of face-to-face and virtual set-up held on February 16, 2023 at Palayok ni Jing Restaurant and Catering Services, Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro. The representative of the academe through Polytechnic University of the Philippines (PUP) Sablayan Campus, Mr. Algene Eduard M. Francisco, presided the meeting. Below are the main agenda discussed and actions taken including four (4) resolutions approved:

Agenda	Highlights and/or Actions Taken
1. Presentation of Accomplishment 1 st Quarter, 2023	PASu Villanada stated that the waters of ARNP exceeded the standard for <i>Class SA</i> and <i>SB</i> . Mindoro Biodiversity Conservation Foundation Inc. (MBCFI) representative, Ms. Bantiling suggested to coordinate with Environmental Management Bureau (EMB) regarding the issue on oil and grease in ARNP. Division Director Capt. Rodil of Philippine Coast Guard Auxiliary (PCGA) suggested to coordinate with the Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) to advise all mariners to not dispose ballast water near the Protected Area (PA).
2. Ordinance declaring the Phase-out of Single Use Plastics in ARNP	Prof. Francisco, of PUP-Sablayan Campus suggested to include all types of clam shell food container and cling wraps. It was suggested the penalties to be imposed upon approval of the PAMB Ordinance. Oceana and MCBFI signified their intent in helping the PAMO for the information dissemination. <i>PAMB Ordinance No. AR23-001: Declaring the Phase-out of Single Use Plastics in ARNP was approved/affirmed.</i>
3. Adoption of Green Fins Approach: Environmental Guidelines on Diving and Snorkeling	PASu Villanada presented the Technical Bulletin No. 2017-13, which outlines the Guidelines for implementing environmental standards in diving and snorkeling. PASu Villanada clarified that the PAMO would be the main agency overseeing its implementation, while the Reef World

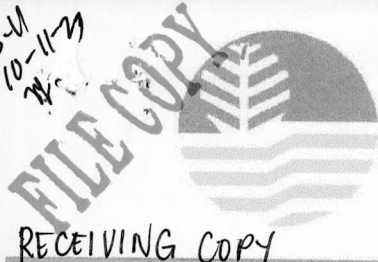

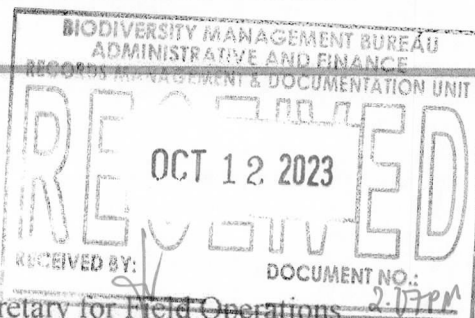

Hereunder are the summarized accomplishments of the 5 PA Rangers of ENMRPA:

1. Regular monitoring as Marshalls (on rotation basis) as the Big and Small Lagoons, Barangay Bebeladan, El Nido to maintain order and avert illegal activities thereat;
2. Inspection at Taraw Cliff on alleged illegal climbing incidence at Purok Puting Bato, Barangay Buena Suerte, El Nido;
3. Conducted follow-up inspection on alleged illegal activities (e.g. clearing in the timberland, construction and fencing within the 40-meter easement) in the PA;
4. Assisted in the inspection and investigation of alleged continuous illegal development and construction of Atalaya Resort at Sitio Lamoro, Pasadeña, El Nido;
5. Assisted in the maintenance of the motorized patrol boat of ENMRPA "Ploning" and Marshall Boat at the Diver's House, Barangay Corong-Corong, El Nido;
6. Manned and maintained the Forest Product Monitoring Station IV (FPMS-IV) at Sitio Lamoro, Barangay Pasadeña, El Nido and assisted in checking/monitoring of vehicles with loads of minor forest products;
