



REPORT ON ALLEGED INDISCRIMINATE AERIAL STRIKES IN

THE ISLAND PROVINCES OF ORIENTAL AND OCCIDENTAL

MINDORO

This refers to the alleged indiscriminate aerial strikes in the island provinces of Oriental and Occidental Mindoro, which was one of the issues raised during the deliberation of DENR's proposed budget for FY 2024 last August 16, 2023.

Please be informed that based on the reports of the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Officers (PENRO) concerned, there were no incidents of aerial bombing and reported damage to biodiversity in the said provinces.

Our PENRO, Oriental Mindoro, informed us of an encounter between the military group and Communist Party that took place at Barangay Tawas, Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro on May 8, 2023. However, no casualties and damages on properties were reported in the area. Likewise, there was no report of incident regarding aerial bombing, shelling and strafing in the province's protected area, the Naujan Lake National Park.

Similarly, our PENRO, Occidental Mindoro also reported that based on their coordination with the Philippine Army, no such incident of bombing happened in Occidental Mindoro.

Please find the attached letter of this Office addressed to National Mapping and Resource Information Authority (NAMRIA) requesting for assistance in the issuance of any certification, document or maps reflecting mangrove forest loss due to reclamation in Coron by the Coron Bay Development Project, for the proposed Coron Public Market and other infrastructure projects. The request stemmed from our difficulty in producing witnesses on the actual cutting of mangroves prior to the reclamation projects.

In our initial discussion with the Legal Division, the documented time series photos sourced from the Google Earth may have legal standing when presented in court if duly certified as coming from an official source or database. Hence, in order to support our findings via Google Earth time series that indeed mangroves have been cut as a result of the reclamation, this Office seeks assistance from NAMRIA to have a valid and legal evidence thru the use of land cover change datasets for the filing of cases against perpetrators.

Further, may we also request for your guidance on this matter.
