

### **I. BACKGROUND**

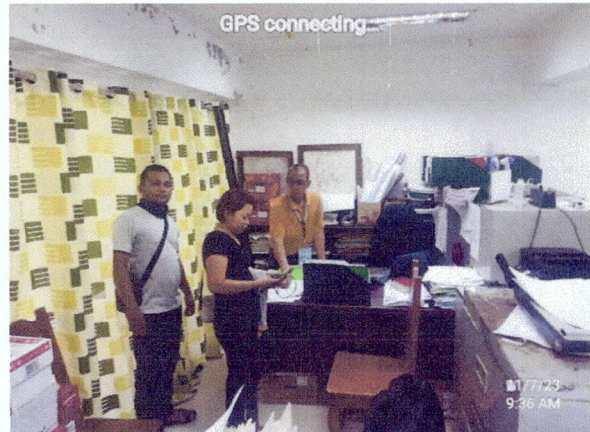
The Municipality of San Andres is situated along the coast and is highly dependent on its coastal resources for livelihood and tourism. San Andres has been classified as a 5th municipality with 13 barangays and a total land area of 11,200 hectares and the coastline is approximately 17.74 kilometers (km) in length. Recognizing the importance of sustainable resource management and community participation, the Local Government Unit of San Andres expressed their interest in incorporating Integrated Coastal Management (ICM) principles into their Comprehensive Land Use Plan.

### **II. MAINSTREAMING PHASE**

In response to their request, our office initiated a series of meetings and consultations with the Municipality of San Andres. The objective was to facilitate the mainstreaming of ICM concepts, strategies, and approaches into the CLUP. The following activities were carried out:

1. The Conservation and Development Section thru the Coastal Resources and Foreshore Management Unit convened a series of meeting with the Municipal Planning and Development Coordination (MPDC) of LGU-San Andres to discuss the details and requirements for mainstreaming ICM into the CLUP. During this meeting, we assessed the municipality's current land use practices, identified gaps and opportunities, and established a roadmap for the integration process.

2. We conducted a Workshop on the Vision Setting (Step 3 of the mainstreaming phase) for CLUP Technical Working Group members and other stakeholders of LGU San Andres on September 28-29, 2023. This workshop aimed to enhance their understanding of ICM principles, tools, and practices, as well as foster their active participation in the integration process. Key topics covered included Basic Concepts and Principles of ICM, Mainstreaming Process of ICM into the CLUP, Key Steps on the Vision Setting and Workshop on the Vision Statement of the LGU on the ICM. The workshop also covered Step 4: Analysis of Situation and Step 5: Set the Goals and Objectives of the mainstreaming phase.

The workshop enabled the participants to collectively craft a shared vision for sustainable coastal development in the area. In addition, the ICM Goals and Objectives were also included acknowledging the importance of sustainable coastal resource management and ecosystem conservation. These goals and objectives align with national ICM frameworks and guidelines.

3. Throughout the integration process, our office provided technical assistance to the municipal planning team by reviewing and providing feedback on their drafts, sharing best practices from other municipalities, and offering guidance on mapping coastal resources and vulnerable areas. This assistance ensured that the CLUP would reflect a well-informed and comprehensive approach to coastal management.



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### **III. CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATION**

While significant progress has been made in mainstreaming ICM into the CLUP of San Andres Municipality, there are still ongoing efforts to further refine and implement the plan. The next steps would be review and finalization of the ICM Plan into the CLUP, approval and adoption, implementation, and monitoring.

The mainstreaming of ICM into the CLUP of San Andres Municipality has been a valuable collaborative effort. Through technical assistance, meetings and workshop, our office has assisted the municipality in incorporating ICM practices, principles, and approaches into their development planning process. We are confident that this integration will contribute to the sustainable management and conservation of the municipality's coastal resources.
